HEALTH & SAFETY CODE CHAPTER 38. PEDICULOSIS OF MINORS

Sec. 38.001. PROGRAM ESTABLISHED. (a) The department shall establish and develop a state program for the control and

eradication of pediculosis of minors.

(b) The program may include procedures for detection of pediculosis and instructions for treatment.
