Created as a result of Senate Bill 586 of the 75th Legislature, the Board consists of members from each HHS region who were appointed by statutory Probate Court Judges because of their knowledge of guardianship needs and services. Description and Justification for Continuation/Consequences of Abolishing

House Bill 2292 of the 78th Legislative Session, Section 2.08 amends Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, by adding Section 531.067 that requires the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to appoint a Public Assistance Health Benefit Review and Design Committee.

The purpose of the committee is to (1) review benefits provided under medical assistance programs that receive state funds and; (2) review procedures for addressing high utilization of benefits by recipients. The committee will make recommendations to HHSC for consideration.

The legislation stipulates that the nine-member committee must include representatives of health care providers participating in the Medicaid program, the Child Health Insurance Program (CHIP) or both; including at least three providers from each program.

In January of 2006, The Public Assistance Health Benefit Review and Design Committee appointed a sub-committee composed of the Texas Pediatric Society Committee on Pediatric Infectious Disease and Immunizations to advise on Respiratory Syncytial Virus.
