ATR Client/Service Eligibility

Clients are eligible for ATR services if they meet at least one of the following criteria:

1. Drug Court Clients:

Client is an active participant in a Drug Court that meets the 10 key components as specified in Texas health and Safety Code (Health & Safety Code 469.001). Drug court clients must be involved in and referred by a participating drug court which has signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of State health Services (DSHS).

Clients are eligible for licensed treatment and recovery support services.

2. CPS clients:

At time of assessment, clients must have an case with CPS in an ATR county.

Clients are eligible for licensed treatment and recovery support services.

3. Probation clients:

At time of assessment, clients must have an active probation case in an ATR county.

Clients are eligible for licensed treatment and recovery support services.

4. Katrina evacuee:

Client is a Louisiana resident displaced by Katrina and currently living in an ATR County.

Clients are eligible for licensed treatment and recovery support services.

Eligibility for the ATR Program will end when the Client is discharged from the drug court program for reasons deemed appropriate by the Court, or the authorized voucher funds are expended.
