Yes, Rule 128.7(d) (3) allows the average weekly wage for TIBs be adjusted to zero for a period a school district employee would not have earned wages and no minimum benefit payment may be required.  2. No, the AWW cannot be reduced to zero for IIBs, LIBS, or SIBs for a school district employee according to Rule 128.7(e).
