Prior to installing GenEdits Plus 1.0.6, you must first remove any previous version of GenEdits Plus by following the instructions found in figures 1-3. If you do not have a previous version of GenEdits Plus on your computer, skip to figure 4.




Figure 2 - Click "Add or Remove Programs" to remove your previous version of GenEdits Plus




Figure 3 – Click the "Remove" button and "Yes" to remove the previous version of GenEdits Plus.

Start here if you did not have a previous version of GenEdits Plus to remove.




Figure 4 – Using your internet browser, go to the following web address www.dshs.state.tx.us/tcr/genedits.shtm. Click download GenEdits Plus version 1.0.6 Installation and click "Run" (*Windows XP*) or "Open" (*Windows 2000*) – it should begin downloading (if you get "unknown publisher" message click "Run" or "Open".



Figure 5 – Click "OK" to install GenEdits Plus version 1.0.6




Figure 6 – Click "Setup" to continue installing GenEdits Plus version 1.0.6



Figure 7 – Click "Next >", several other dialog boxes will appear – click "Next >" on each of them and then "Finnish".




Figure 8 – If you do not have a GenEdits Plus icon displaying on your desktop, then open the C: folder and go to C:\RegPlus\GenEDITSplus (make sure you minimize it so you can see your desktop in the background like the example above. Right click (and hold) on GEPlus.exe – then drag to your desktop (*background behind GEPlus box*). You will then select "Create shortcuts here" and release the mouse button to add the icon as shown above in this example.




Figure 9 – GenEdits Plus 1.0.6 tab 3 should already be configured with the proper default settings, which are established in the texas.ini configuration file.




Figure 10 – GenEdits Plus 1.0.6 tab 1, Select File and Run, configured with the proper Metafile Name, Record Layout, and Edit Set. The default settings are established in the texas.ini configuration file.




Figure 11 – GenEdits Plus 1.0.6 tab 2, Report Configuration, set to default fields Accession number, Last and First names for identification. The default settings are established in the texas.ini configuration file.
