



PATIENT RESPONSIBILITIES DURING HOSPITALIZATION AT TCID

- A. You are responsible to provide, to the best of your knowledge, accurate and complete information. You are responsible to report unexpected changes in condition to the responsible practitioner. You are responsible for reporting whether you clearly comprehend a contemplated course of action and what is expected of you during your treatment.**
- B. You are responsible for following the treatment plan recommended by the attending physician and patient care team responsible for your care. This includes instructions of nurses and allied health personnel as they carry out the coordinated plan of care, implement the physician’s orders, and enforce applicable Center rules and regulations.**
- C. You are responsible for your actions if you refuse treatment or do not follow instructions.**
- D. You are responsible for assuring that the financial obligations of your health care are fulfilled.**
- E. You are responsible for following the Center’s rules and regulations affecting patient care and conduct.**
- F. You are responsible for being considerate of the rights of other patients, volunteers, visitors and TCID personnel. You are responsible for being respectful of the property of other patients and of the Center.**
