FISH AND SHELLFISH CONSUMPTION ADVISORY

ADV-24

This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of Lake Meredith, in Hutchinson, Moore, and Potter Counties. Samples of fish taken from Lake Meredith indicate the presence of mercury at concentrations that may pose a threat to human health if consumed.

COUNTY: Hutchinson, Moore, and Potter

AREA: Lake Meredith


SPECIES AFFECTED: Walleye

CONTAMINANT: Mercury

CONSUMPTION ADVISORY: Adults should limit consumption of walleye from this lake to no more than two (2) eight-ounce meals per month. Children should limit consumption of walleye from this lake to no more than two (2) four-ounce meals per month.

This advisory shall remain in effect until rescinded or modified in writing.
