
**FISH AND SHELLFISH CONSUMPTION ADVISORY**

**ADV-27**

Samples of fish collected from Martin Creek Reservoir located in Rusk and Panola Counties; Brandy Branch Reservoir located in Harrison County and Welsh Reservoir located in Titus County, which had been covered by a consumption advisory issued May 11, 1992, indicate that concentrations of contaminants have decreased to acceptable levels. Consumption of fish from Martin Creek Reservoir located in Rusk and Panola Counties; Brandy Branch Reservoir located in Harrison County and Welsh Reservoir located in Titus County no longer poses a threat to human health.

ADV – 4 for Martin Creek Reservoir, Brandy Branch Reservoir, and Welsh Reservoir are hereby rescinded.
