- Applications will not be approved until all required application documentation has been reviewed and verified.
- A certification that has expired for one year or more may not be renewed. The firm may obtain a new certification by complying with the requirements for obtaining a new certification.
- If the firm's certification certificate has been lost or stolen, you must submit an Application for Replacement along with the appropriate fee of \$20.

- If the firm operates under an assumed name, the owner or authorized agent of the firm shall provide to the department with their Lead Firm application a copy of the firm's Certificate of Assumed Name that lists the firm's Assumed Name of Business, the address of the firm, and the name of the person registering the firm as an assumed name §295.211(b)(4)
