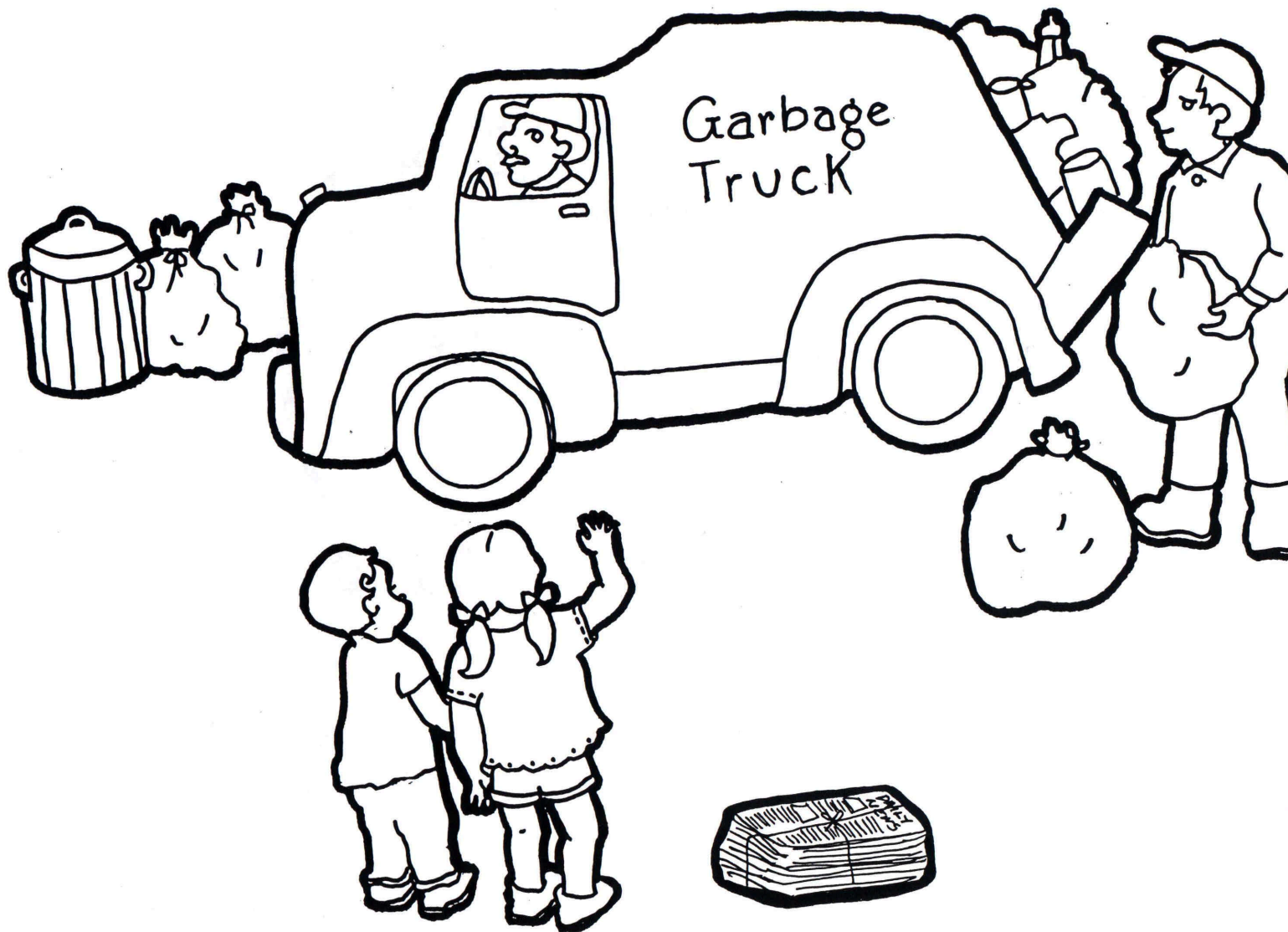

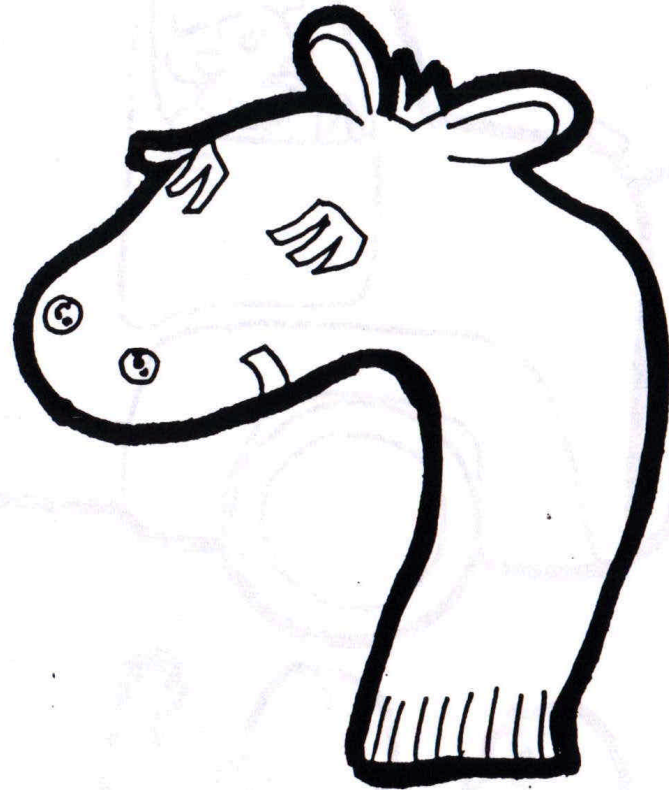

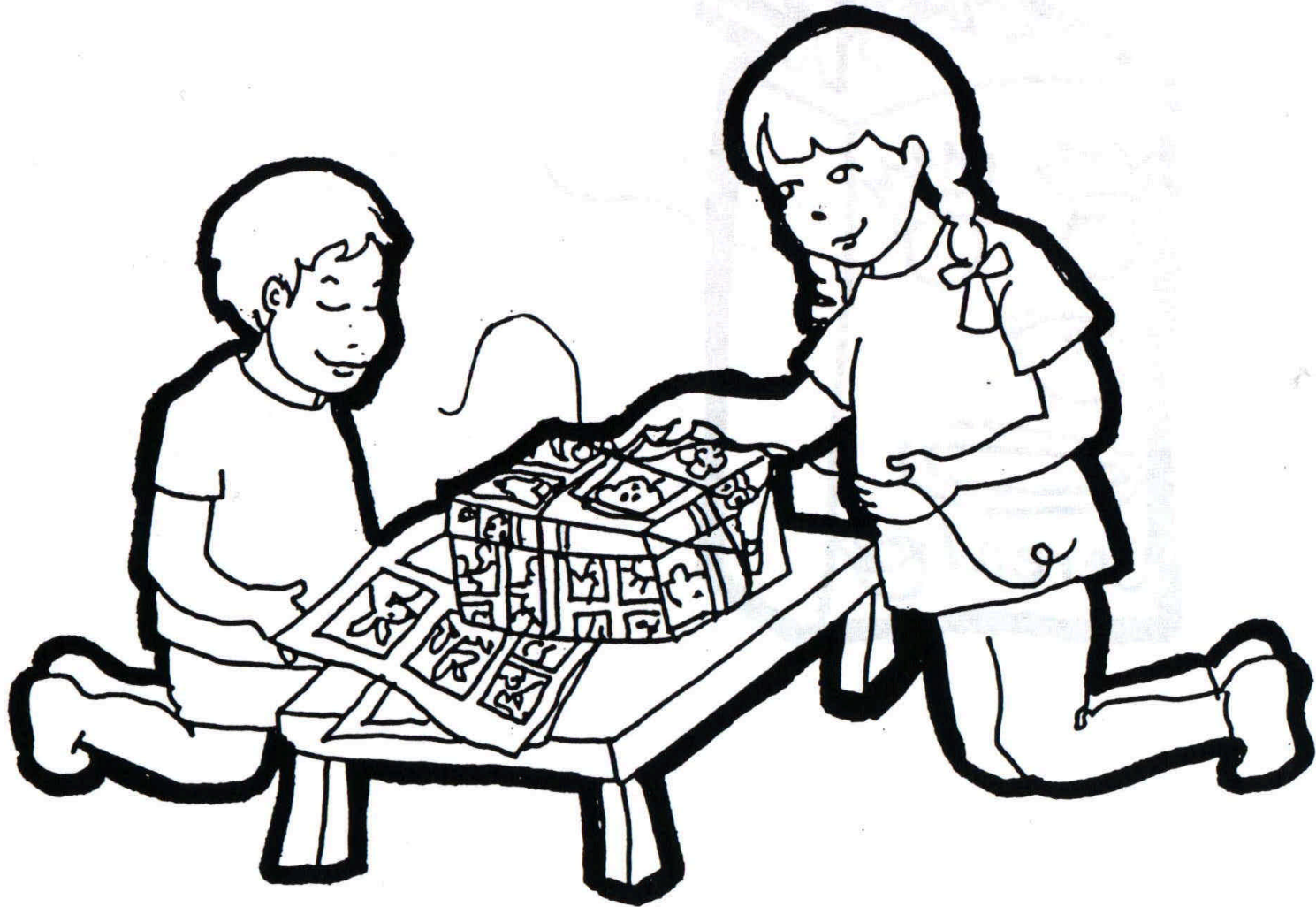
The earth needs your help. There is too much garbage on the earth and no place to put it all!

it can be used again! RECYCLE!



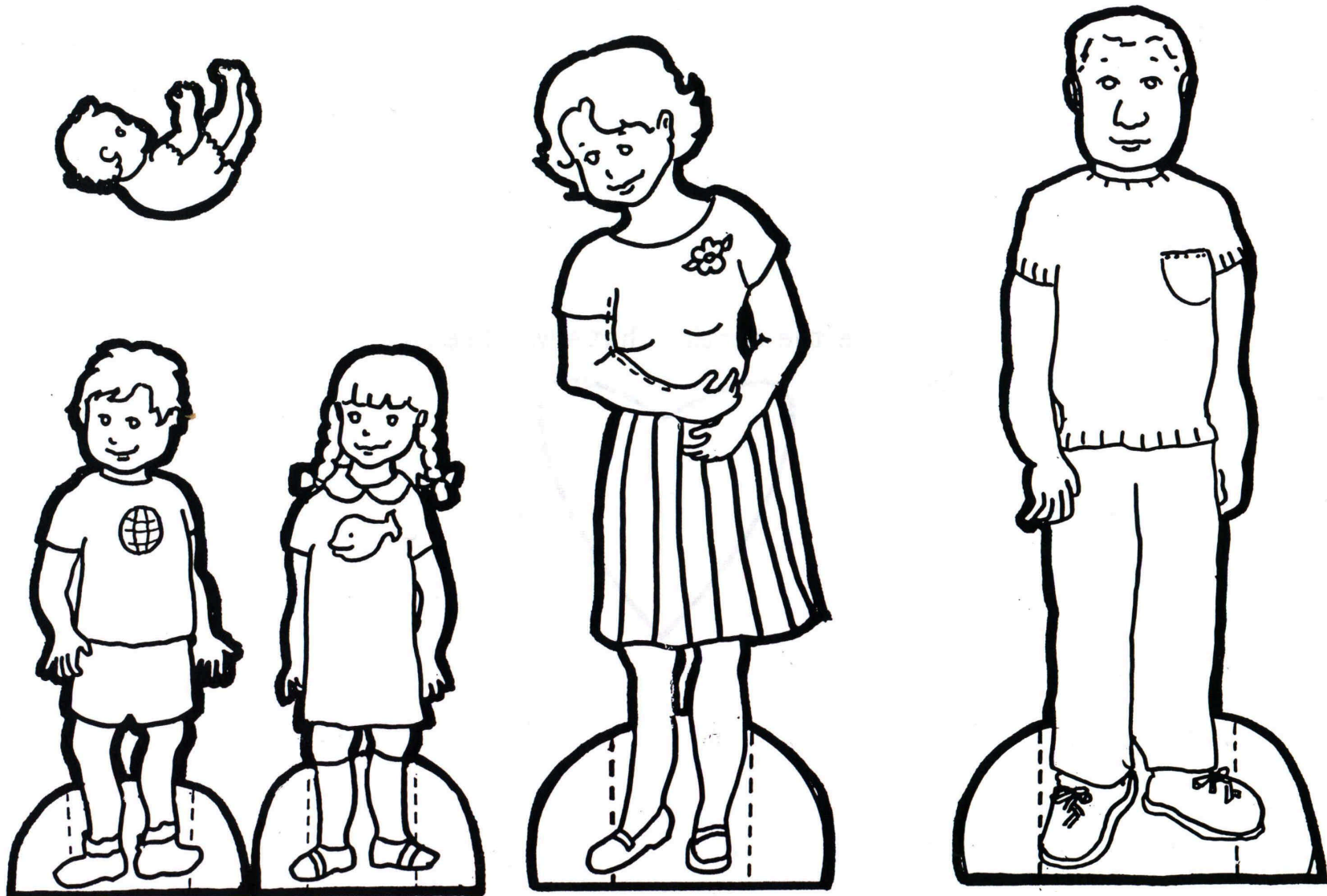
RECYCLE clothes, toys and books. Make a sock puppet.
You will need: old sock, safety scissors, glue, buttons, scraps of material.



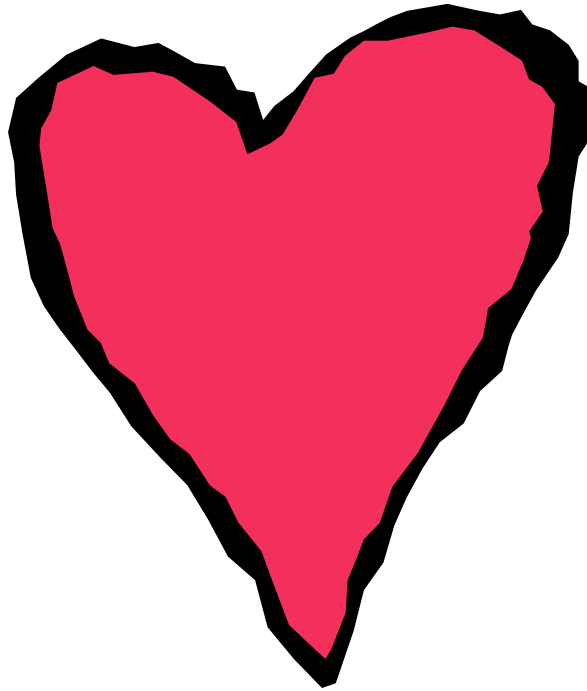
