Texas Immunization Registry

ImmTrac is the Texas immunization registry, a free service of the Texas Department of State Health Services. It is a secure, confidential registry that stores your child's immunization information electronically, in one centralized system. Authorized professionals such as doctors, nurses and public health providers, as well as schools and licensed child care facilities, can access your child's vaccination history. ImmTrac allows you to obtain your child's shot record anytime, at no cost.
