Dear Provider,

Materials you received from DSHS in September and November indicated that the expansion of the Newborn Screening program would be implemented in early 2007. Due to a faster implementation than originally estimated, DSHS was able to report abnormal results in December 2006.

To protect the health of the newborn child, contact with providers was made as soon as the abnormal test results were available. We understand that these notifications may have caused some confusion since they came before the announced implementation date. We regret that these notifications may have caused confusion and we hope that you now have all of the information you need regarding the expansion.

Barring an unanticipated delay, the reporting of all screening results will begin the week of Feb. 5, 2007.
