Over five million ImmTrac records – and counting

ImmTrac contains immunization records for over five million Texas children under the age of 18. This important information comes from a variety of sources including private health care providers, public health clinics, Medicaid claims administrators, the Bureau of Vital Statistics, and Women, Infants and Children (WIC) clinics. Regardless of the number of sources, each child's immunization information is consolidated into one record.

One-stop source for vaccine histories

ImmTrac is a one-stop source for vaccine histories from multiple providers. It keeps track of immunizations due and overdue so you can send reminder notices to parents. This prevents under- or over-immunization of children, which reduces unnecessary costs to families and third-party payors and eliminates needless discomfort for children. **ImmTrac** can also help measure vaccine coverage rates in specific communities.

Parents value ImmTrac's privacy

Parents appreciate knowing the status of their children's vaccinations, receiving reminders of immunization due dates, and knowing that their child's records are protected. A child's information can only be entered into and released from **ImmTrac** with the one-time written consent of the parent, legal guardian, or managing conservator. Only authorized professionals can access the child's information.
