Defining the Territory

- "State publication" means information in any format that:
 - is produced by the authority of or at the total or partial expense of a state agency or is required to be distributed under law by the agency; and
 - is publicly distributed outside the agency





Limiting the Scope

- "State publication" does not include information the distribution of which is limited to:
 - contractors with or grantees of the agency
 - persons within the agency or within other government agencies (most state records)
 - members of the public under a request made under the open records law



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E-Pubs & the Internet

- Late 1980's, early 1990's: confluence of integrated library systems and the world wide web
- Proliferation of web-based information
- New technology = Better access?

Electronic Publications


- 1990's
 - increased interest in and contributions to developing standards
 - government information locators
 - Texas Records and Information Locator (TRAIL)




TRAIL

- Originally, a list of state agency & university web sites
- By the mid-1990's, updates to depository program rules require agencies to report their publications
- By the late-1990's, TRAIL becomes a genuine searchable database
















































New Concerns

- Persistence : it was there yesterday
- Accessibility : retrospective compatibility
- Uneven compliance with depository law
- Librarians in Texas and members of Texas Library Association push for more comprehensive program to address electronic publications, resulting in ...





Electronic Depository Program

- A place where researchers can "reconstruct" an agency website, as it existed on a particular date
- A system to store electronic publications indefinitely
- A user-friendly system for contributors and researchers





Building the EDP

- Identify needs and resources
- Plan the project
- Fine tune the components
- Implement





Identifying Needs/Resources

- Vision: Texas government information will be preserved for future researchers – for electronic publications just as for printed ones.
- Building Blocks :
 - TLA Government Documents Round Table
 - TRAIL, TSLAC mission, existing print program
 - Standards (Z39.50, Dublin Core, etc.)
 - Telecommunications Infrastructure Fund grant



Planning

- Government Information Team (1)
- Setting our own:
 - Collection development standards (2)
 - Cooperative agreements standards (3)
 - Specifications for hardware & software (4)
 - Metadata (5)



Planning 1: Government Information Team

Mission

- To use knowledge & experience of professionals in appropriate fields
- To create standards, etc., for program

Constituency

 archivists, publications program staff, catalogers, records managers, reference librarians, information technology staff, and TRAIL staff



Planning 2: Collection Development Plan

- Key Terms (e.g. "state publication," "MIME," "version or edition")
- Guiding Assumptions (no-fee access, government has duty to provide, materials to be collected)
- Selection for retention based on MIME type and Publication type
- Retention standard (= permanent)





Common MIME Types

- HTML format (.htm or .html)
- Adobe Portable Document (.pdf)
- Word Processing Documents (.doc or .wpd)
- Spreadsheet Documents (Example .xls)
- Slideshow Documents (Example .ppt)
- Text format (.txt)
- Zipped files (.zip)
- Other similar file types





Common Publication Types

- Agency rules, policies and procedures
- Agency search engines
- Agency staff contacts
- Databases
- Employment information
- Executive orders
- External fiscal reports
- Finding aids, indexes, and tracking systems
- Forms and form instructions





Publication Types (cont.)

- Grants or Funding Opportunities
- Homepages
- Legal opinions and advice
- Legislation, proposed legislation, and statutes
- Legislative Appropriations Requests
- Licenses and licensing information
- Manuals and instructions
- Maps
- Meeting agendas





Publication Types (cont.)

- Meeting minutes
- News or press releases
- Organization charts
- Periodicals Newsletters and magazines
- Personnel policies and procedures
- Plans and planning information
- Programs and services
- Reference materials
- Reports Biennial or Annual





Publication Types (cont.)

- Miscellaneous reports
- Non-fiscal reports and studies
- Reports on performance measures
- Reports Required legislative
- Speeches and papers
- Statistics
- Strategic plans
- Training materials
- Other publications [not elsewhere classified]





- "Memorandum of Understanding"
- Defines roles & responsibilities of TSLAC and its partner(s) in the project
- Partner gets a server and provides public access, bandwidth & routine technical upkeep of own system.
- TSLAC provides search interface, software, archival server and document files for partner
- Partners agree to assist each other if disaster recovery is needed.






- GIT developed specifications for "request for offer" (= bid)
- Specifications include "must have" and "would like" categories, with measures.
- New system must build on existing TRAIL
- Vendor selection based on scores received in bid evaluation.



Planning 5: Metadata

- Based on work of National Library of Australia
- Descriptive Metadata (supplied by liaisons/authors)
 - Title [Title tag]
 - Description (narrative) [DC.Description tag]
 - Keyword [DC.Subject.Keyword tag]
 - Subject [DC.Subject tag]
 - Publication Type [DC.Type tag]
- Preservation Metadata (supplied by software)
 - file size
 - MIME type
 - version or edition

- Previous Method
 - Liaison reports to TRAIL

 (i.e., creates a meta-data record), one per document.
 - System checks MIME and publication types
 - Review for completeness

- New Method
 - Website harvested
 - System checks for required fields and controlled vocabulary
 - System either alerts liaison to provide additional information or adds record to TRAIL





Completeness Issues

- Simple: Plain Text, PDF, etc.
- Complex: HTML files
 - Text
 - Images
 - Scripts (.asp, .jsp, etc.)
 - Links to continuation pages
- Assignment of Preservation Metadata





Distribution

- To archival server (TSLAC)
 - Must be searchable from TRAIL
- To public access server (partner)
 - Must load file & verify functionality
 - Must verify link from TRAIL
 - May link to own public access catalog
 - May provide additional access points






On-going Activities

- Scheduling automated harvests
 - Expected to run monthly
- Alert & follow-up with liaisons (p.r.n.)
- Upgrades & maintenance
- Evaluation of service
- Modifications to processes as changes occur in the law, common practices, standards, etc.









Future Phases

- More Complex Document Types
- Additional Hardware & Software
- Migration Planning / Emulation
- Expanding Scope
 - University web sites
 - Quasi state agencies (COGs, water authorities, etc.)
 - Current legislative changes
