## 14

Fourteen (14) years is the minimum age for work.

## **Work Permits**

Issued by the school
14 and 15 year-olds are required
to get a work permit from their
school before work begins.

## **Hours of Work**

14 and 15 year-olds may work:

#### From Tuesday after Labor Day to May 31<sup>st</sup>

3 hours on a school day; 8 hours on a non-school day; 18 hours in a school week between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

## From June 1st to Labor Day 8 hours on a non-school day,

40 hours in a non-school week between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m.

#### Break Periods

30 minutes for every 5 hours worked; 1 hour for every 8 hours worked

# **Some Work Restrictions** *Minors under 16 years CAN NOT be employed in work related to:*

- Construction
- Cooking or bakingFryers or grills
- Hyers of grinsHoisting devices
- Ladders or scaffolds
  - Lawn mower & weed eater,
- other than working for self
- Loading / unloading
  Manufacturing, mining or
- processingMotor vehicles or service as
  - helpers on vehicles
     Power-driven machines or
- equipmentPublic messenger service
- Public utitilities and communications
- Slicers or sharp knives
   Transportation of persons or property by rail, highway
- air, water, pipeline or other means
- Warehousing or storage,

and any occupation declared particularly hazardous by federal law, federal regulations or the Commissioner of Labor.
