The awards will be presented in five categories:

Small employers (50 employees or less)
Medium employers (50-250 employees)
Large employers (more than 250 employees)
Public organizations (city, county, state, public schools, public trusts, etc.)
Safety Culture Award (organizations that have maintained a strong safety and health program over a long period of time and have shown continued low injury/illness rates and workers' compensation costs)
