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Conversion of the *International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems*, 10th Revision (ICD-10) to the *International Classification of Diseases*, 9th Revision (ICD-9) and the *International Classification of Diseases*, 9th Revision, *Clinical Modification*, Fourth Edition (ICD-9-CM)

Introduction

The *International Classification of Diseases (ICD)* is usually revised every 10 years by the World Health Organization. Since this new edition was planned as a major revision, there is a 15-year span, from 1977-1992. Oncologists and epidemiologists often are interested in studying trends in cancer incidence and mortality, so it is imperative that they be able to compare data with codes from different revisions of the ICD's. This conversion was developed to convert or compare the Neoplasm Section (chapter II) of the *International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems*, Tenth Revision (ICD-10)¹ to the *International Classification of Diseases*, 1975, Ninth Revision (ICD-9)² and the *International Classification of Diseases*, Ninth Revision, *Clinical Modification*, (ICD-9-CM).³

The neoplasm section - Chapter II of the *International Classification of Diseases - Ninth Revision (ICD-9)* is principally a topographic code for neoplasms taking into account the behavior (malignant, benign, etc.) of the tumor. Only a few histologic types such as melanomas, lymphomas, leukemias, and a few benign types, such as lipomas, leiomyomas and hemangiomas, have specific categories in ICD-9. Most of these do not take site into consideration. In the United States ICD-9 must be used for coding death certificates. In addition in the United States, the *International Classification of Diseases*, Ninth Revision, *Clinical Modification (ICD-9-CM)*, which is adapted from ICD-9, is used for coding morbidity in all hospitals. This book is now in the 4th edition. It must be used for coding diagnoses which submit claims for third party payment. There are very slight differences between the two books in the Neoplasm Chapter, but the differences are shown in this book. The phrase "ICD-9-(CM)" indicates a code and term which are found in both ICD-9 and in ICD-9-CM.

The majority of the time the direct conversion and the specific codes are the same, meaning there is no change in definition. However, at other times, since there was a division of the ICD-9-(CM) category, there will be a collapse or consolidation of codes in the conversion from ICD-10 to ICD-9-(CM). Also, since codes are collapsed in this direction, there is no need to review cases. Ranges of ICD-10 codes are not always consecutive, i.e., some

codes have not been utilized, namely: C27, C28, C29, C35, C36, C42, C59, C86, C87, C89 and D08. Since publication of ICD-10, Vol. 1, the code C14.1 has been eliminated. Laryngopharynx, which was originally C14.1, has been changed to C13.9.

As can be seen from the page layout in part I of this conversion, the left hand side of each page has the categories and terms from chapter II of ICD-10, volume 1 (numeric index). Part I begins with the malignant neoplasm category C00._ (malignant neoplasm of lip). On the right side of the page is the equivalent category or categories in ICD-9-(CM). There are two columns for the categories in ICD-9-(CM). One is "ICD-9 Direct Computer Conversion" the other is "Specific ICD-9-(CM) Category". As has been mentioned above, many site categories are collapsed or consolidated when converted in this direction. For example, C54.1 (Endometrium), and C54.2 (Myometrium), C54.3 (Fundus uteri) and C54.9 (Corpus uteri, unspecified) together comprise the single code 182.0 (malignant neoplasm of the corpus uteri) in ICD-9-(CM) and each of these codes are converted to the general 182.0 code. Conversely, two terms in ICD-9-(CM). were collapsed into a single code in ICD-10, e.g. 190.2, Lacrimal gland and 190.7, Lacrimal duct, became C69.5, Lacrimal gland in ICD-10. In this scenario the "Direct Computer Conversion" will be the more generic 190.9 since most users do not have the time to review all records. For this reason terms and categories are shown in the column headed "Specific ICD-9-(CM) Category."

A computer conversion has been made with the categories suggested in the "ICD-9 Direct Computer Conversion" column. Part II is an aid to such programming for conversion of ICD-10 to ICD-9-(CM): it includes only the ICD-10 categories and the direct conversion column of part I, which shows the equivalent ICD-9-(CM) code categories. No terms are given in part II. An attempt has been made to convert 3-digit terms of ICD-10, but it is sometimes difficult to do this and a very unspecific term must be resorted to. If someone does use only 3-digit terms, these cases would have to be hand-reviewed. There are a few 4-digit terms, mostly in the .8 category (overlapping) that are also impossible or difficult to convert. Since they are in the minority, they could be hand-reviewed.

The traditional ICD structure has been retained, but an alphanumeric coding scheme replaces the previous numeric one. This provides a larger coding frame and leaves room for future revision without disruption of the numbering system. Chapter II, "Neoplasms" has been subjected to field-testing although the changes in its content have been of a minor nature.

The editors of ICD-10 tried to keep changes at the 3-character level of the malignant neoplasm section to a minimum. However, some changes were necessary. Three new categories have been added, namely, Mesothelioma (C45) and Kaposi's sarcoma (C46) and independent (primary) multiple sites (C97). These categories will convert back to a generic "other" or "unspecified" category.

Changes at the 3-digit level, which are to be collapsed into a single ICD-9-(CM) code, include the following:

- Base of tongue (C01) and other and unspecified parts of tongue (C02) are converted to malignant neoplasm of tongue (141).
- Parotid gland (C07) and other unspecified major salivary glands (C08) are collapsed to major salivary glands (142).
- Tonsil (C09) and oropharynx (C10) are combined into oropharynx (146).
- Pyriform sinus (C12) and hypopharynx (C13) are changed to hypopharynx (148).
- Rectosigmoid junction (C19), rectum (C20) and anus and anal canal (C21) revert to malignant neoplasms of rectum, rectosigmoid junction and anus (154).
- Gallbladder (C23) and other and unspecified parts of biliary tract (C24) are converted to gallbladder and extrahepatic bile ducts (156).
- Nasal cavity and middle ear (C30) and accessory sinuses (C31) collapse to nasal cavities, middle ear and accessory sinuses (160) in ICD-9.
- Trachea (C33) and bronchus and lung (C34) are combined into trachea, bronchus and lung (162).
- Thymus (C37) and heart, mediastinum and pleura (C38) revert to thymus, heart and mediastinum (164).

- The two categories of malignant neoplasm of bone and articular cartilage, one of limbs (C40) and the other of other and unspecified sites (C41) become bones and articular cartilage (170).
- In ICD-10 there are separate categories for peripheral nerves and autonomic nervous systems (C47) and other connective and soft tissue (C49). In ICD-9-(CM) peripheral nerves, sympathetic and para-sympathetic nervous system are coded to the single category of connective and other soft tissue (171).
- Ovary (C56) and other and unspecified female genital organs (C57) are converted back to ovary and other uterine adnexa (183).
- Vulva (C51) and vagina (C52) are collapsed into other and unspecified female genital organs (184).
- The two categories of penis (C60) and other and unspecified male genital organs (C63) are changed into penis and other male genital organs (187).
- Kidney, except renal pelvis (C64), renal pelvis (C65), ureter (C66) and other and unspecified urinary organs (C68) all collapse into kidney and other and unspecified urinary organs (189).
- Meninges (C70) and malignant neoplasms of spinal cord, cranial nerves and other parts of central nervous system (C72) are changed back to other and unspecified parts of nervous system (192).
- Adrenal gland (C74) and other endocrine glands and related structures (C75) are converted to the generic category of other endocrine glands and related structures (194).
- Among the categories of lymphoid, hematopoietic and related tissue, the categories for Hodgkin's disease (C81), follicular (nodular) non-Hodgkin's lymphoma (C82), diffuse non-Hodgkin's lymphoma (C83), peripheral and cutaneous T-cell lymphomas (C84) and other unspecified types of non-Hodgkin's lymphoma (C85) fall into either lymphosarcoma and reticulosarcoma (200), Hodgkin's disease (201) or other malignant neoplasms of lymphoid and histiocytic tissue (202). Also, malignant immunoproliferative diseases (C88) and multiple myeloma and malignant plasma cell neoplasms (C90) are converted back to multiple myeloma and immunoproliferative neoplasms (203).

There are several instances where the ICD-10 code will divide into two or more ICD-9-(CM) codes. With the introduction of the overlapping lesion categories in ICD-10, there are some cases of two corresponding ICD-9-(CM) categories, namely:

- Tongue (C02.8)
- Oropharynx (C10.8)
- Lip, oral cavity and pharynx (C14.8)
- Female genital organs (C57.8)

The two primary cases of codes being divided in ICD-9-(CM) are Breast (C50._) and Pleura (C38.4).

A complete list will be found in Part I.

An ANSI COBOL computer program has been developed to effect this conversion. The program will be made available upon request. The conversion tables are also available on computer tape if you wish to develop your own computer programs. For further information write:
