NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is reopening the Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The facility above received its initial Title V permit on December 1, 2003. This reopening of the Title V permit addresses permit deficiencies identified by the EPA on October 8, 2004. The reopening also incorporates changes in applicable requirements authorized in an Authority to Construct, addresses issues raised in the refinery's appeal to the December 16, 2004 permit, and addresses some refinery comments. There is no increase in emissions associated with these changes.

All changes are clearly shown in "strikeout/underline format" and have been addressed in the statement of basis. The proposed permit changes have no effect on emissions. The District invites comments on these changes. All comments must be received by May 24, 2005. The public may also request a public hearing for this reopening of the permit.

Reopenings of Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and the District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the decision to not object to the permit.
