This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision and is issuing an administrative amendment to the Major Facility Review Permit for Redwood Landfill, Inc., Facility Number A1179, and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The purpose of this proposed minor permit revision is to add two sources to the MFR Permit for Site # A1179: S-56 Portable Horizontal Grinder (a new significant source) and S-58 Aerated Leachate Pond (a new permitted source). This revision will increase the facility wide potential to emit by 10.00 tons PM<sub>10</sub>/year from S-56 and 0.08 tons POC/year from S-58. Offsets were supplied for the POC emission increases from S-58. The District is also proposing to add one term to the glossary. This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.

The purpose of the administrative amendment is to delete the S-50 Leachate Vaporator from the MFR Permit for Site # A1179. This source has been permanently shut down and will be removed from this facility. This amendment will reduce the facility wide potential to emit by: 3.10 tons SO<sub>2</sub>/year, 1.83 tons NO<sub>x</sub>/year, 1.83 tons CO/year, 0.30 tons POC/year, and 0.20 tons PM<sub>10</sub>/year.
