The District proposed a significant permit revision for this facility on June 29, 2006. The main purpose of this significant revision was to establish an alternative wellhead oxygen standard for five landfill gas collection wells associated with the S-1 Keller Canyon Landfill. The District determined that an alternative oxygen standard of 15% O<sub>2</sub> by volume was appropriate, and proposed to add this limit, applicability criteria, monitoring and record keeping requirements, and other procedures related to the proposed alternative oxygen standard to Condition # 17309, Part 20c and Tables IV-A, VII-A, and VIII. The proposed revisions did not result in any emission increases.

The public comment period ended on August 15, 2006. The EPA comment period ended on August 14, 2006. No comments on this proposed significant revision were received from the public, EPA, or the facility.

The District has decided to issue the revised permit incorporating the proposed significant revision. Enclosed is a copy of the final revised permit. If you have any questions regarding this permit, please call Dennis Jang, Senior Air Quality Engineer, at: (415) 749-4707.
