The NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services periodically trains police officers, DARE Officers, and others in current drug trends. In a cooperative effort between the Division and State Department of Health, Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement, there will be one-day courses on **Prescription Drug Abuse** in the following locations:

All classes held from 9:00a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The specific location will be given upon confirmation of attendance.

This training provides officers a basic understanding of the issues of prescription drug abuse and the growing problem of drug diversion cases. This course trains officers when to use penal law or alternatively, the public health law when dealing with pharmaceutical drug diversion. Topics also include the prescription monitoring program in NYS, identifying prescription forgeries, and security features in the NYS Official Prescription. Officers learn about techniques and targets of drug diverters, doctor shoppers and illegal prescribing by practitioners. Other topics include drug facilitated sexual assault, institutional diversion and confidentiality requirements.

Although we have planned for a large enrollment, seats are limited. Therefore, you must receive confirmation on attendance in order to attend. Please FAX back the attached application to DCJS by the date specified.
