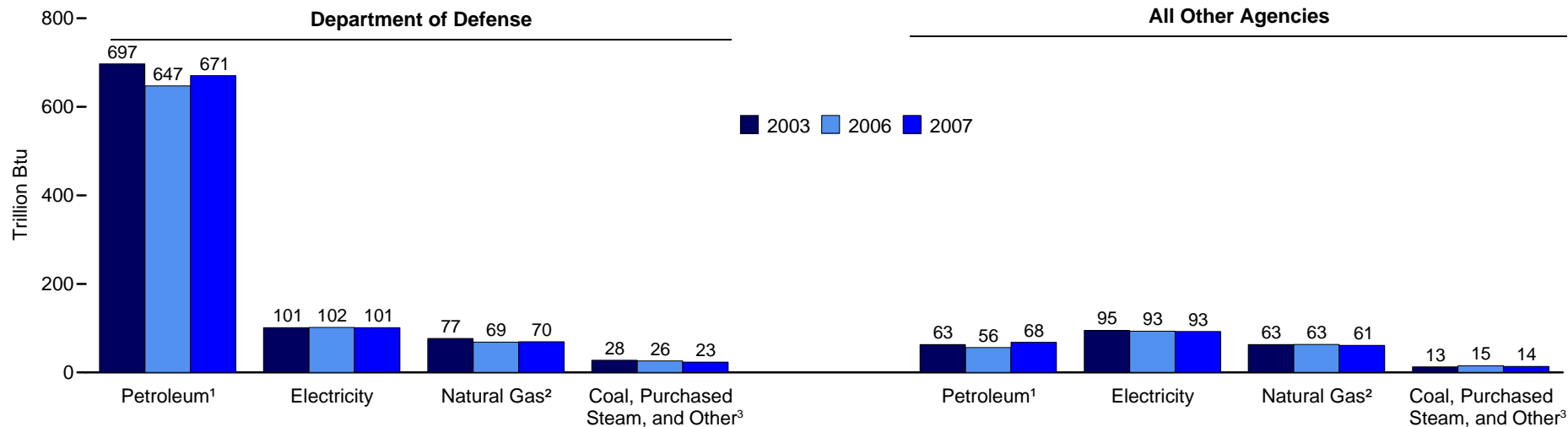
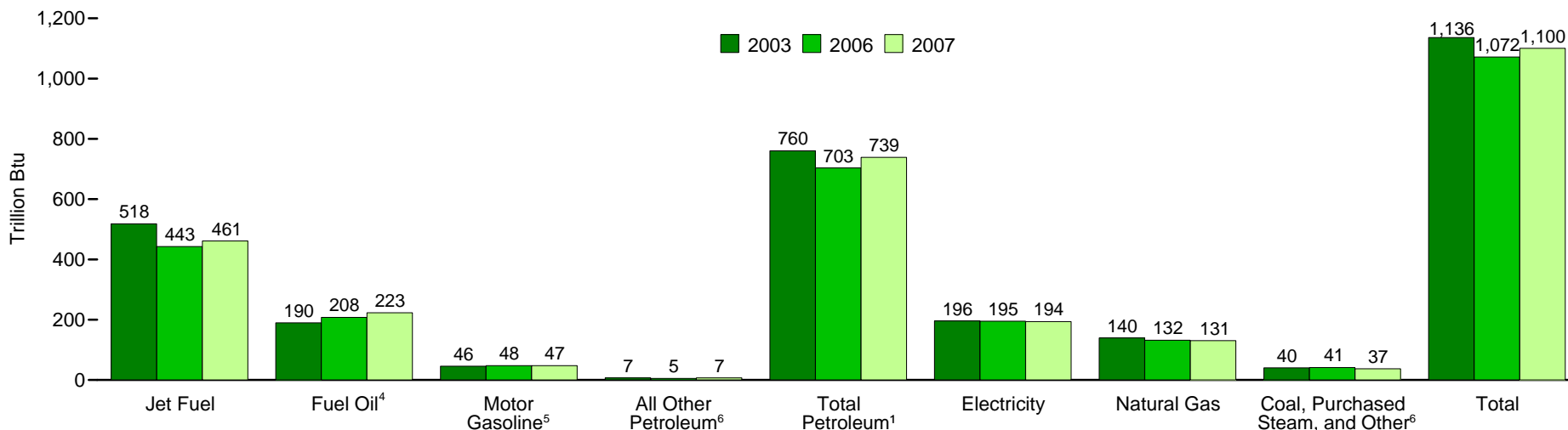


Figure 1.13 U.S. Government Energy Consumption by Agency and Source, Fiscal Years 2003, 2006, and 2007
