Project Description:

A postdoctoral position is available immediately in the Bioenergy Science Center located at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. The successful postdoc will apply, utilize, and develop novel methods for gene expression analysis, DNA polymorphism detection and transcriptional regulation in microorganisms such as Clostridium thermocellum. Existing techniques will include high-density micro arrays analysis and RNA profiling methods will be developed in the context of high-throughput de-novo sequencing (e.g. 454) approaches.

The successful candidate will join a multi-disciplinary team of investigators who apply advanced genomics-enabled techniques o understand the physiology and ecology of microorganisms in support of US DOE missions. There will be opportunities to be involved in other projects as part of the new Bioenergy Science Center, which will utilize a wide range of genomic approaches (including single cell genomics, metabolomics, metagenomics, and environmental proteomics) to develop new ways to convert biomass into biofuels.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate must have a Ph.D. degree in microbiology, molecular biology, genetics, bioinformatics, or relate field. Experience or knowledge is highly desirable in genomic database, use of statistical tools such as R, SAS and bioinformatics analysis tools such as JMP Genomics. Excellent analytical, problem solving, interpersonal skills required, outstanding written and verbal communication skills are requisite. Applicants cannot have received the most recent degree more than five years prior to the date of application and must complete all degree requirements before starting their appointment.
