Project Description:

A postdoctoral position is available in the Biosciences Division at Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) for an individual with training in environmental microbiology and microbial ecology. The successful candidate will be responsible for the following: (1) establish and characterize microbial consortia which are able to produce ethanol from cellulosic biomass; and (2) design and conduct experiments to isolate and characterize novel cellulolytic organisms from diverse environments using high-throughput cultivation methods. The successful candidate will join a multi-disciplinary team of investigators who apply advanced techniques to understand the physiology and ecology of microorganisms in support of US Dept. of Energy missions and will also interact with members of the BioEnergy Science Center (BESC) from other institutions. There will be opportunities to be involved in other projects within the BESC established at ORNL, which will use cuttingedge approaches (including single cell genomics, metagenomics, environmental proteomics and transcriptomics) to study and enhance biomass conversion into biofuels.

Qualifications:

Candidates must have a Ph.D., broad training in microbiology and molecular biology and demonstrated ability to work independently as well as interact with others as part of a team. Expertise in the cultivation of anaerobic microorganisms is highly desired and experience with extremophiles is a plus. The ideal candidate will also have experience in biochemistry and comparative genomics.
