Dear Mr. Christensen:

On October 7, 1996, the Research and Special Programs Administration (now the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration) issued to Koch Pipeline Company L.P. (Koch) a Hazardous Facility Order in the above-referenced case. The order required corrective actions with respect to Koch's highly-volatile liquid pipeline system between Medford, Oklahoma and Mont Belvieu, Texas. An amendment to the order was issued on December 19, 2002, and a second amendment was issued on March 3, 2005 (corrected March 9, 2005). On July 1, 2005, Koch was purchased by ONEOK NGL Pipeline L.P. (ONEOK).

Based on the recommendation of the Director, Southwest Region, it has been determined that ONEOK has complied with the terms of the Order, as amended. Accordingly, this case is now closed. No further action is contemplated with respect to the matters involved in this case.
