

NOTICE TO USERS

Last year, the Census Bureau announced its intention to offer more information in electronic format while reducing the number of printed reports. This change is now being implemented for the P20 Current Population Reports series. Many P20 reports, such as *Fertility of American Women*, are implementing this change.

Instead, to keep you informed of the major findings from the Current Population Survey, short data updates will be produced and made available in both printed and electronic forms. Additionally, the detailed tabulations that have been part of the printed reports will be updated periodically in electronic form on the Internet. If you wish to obtain the new tabulations for June 1995, updating *Fertility of American Women: June 1994* (Current Population Reports, P20-482), please see the "Detailed Tabulations" section at the end of this update.

Our decision to modify the format of the P20 series is based on a variety of factors. Ultimately, we hope this decision will provide users with more timely data on a wider variety of topics. DATA HIGHLIGHTS

Detailed tabulations are now available which provide fertility statistics by selected characteristics for women 15 to 44 years old in the United States, based on the June 1995 Current Population Survey. These tables provide information such as:

- In 1995, women 15 to 44 years old had an average of 1.2 children each.
- About 42 percent of women in the same age group were childless in 1995.
- About 55 percent of women who had a child in the preceding 12-months were in the labor force.
- Of the 22.8 million women who had never been married at the time of survey, 21 percent had given birth to at least one child.
- There were 6.1 million foreign-born women, 15 to 44 years old, whom had borne an average of 1.6 children each.

DETAILED TABULATIONS

The tables include five detailed tables (18 pages), two summary tables, six historical tables, one state table, and two methodological tables, providing demographic characteristics of women by race and Hispanic origin. The electronic version of these tables is available on the Internet, at the Census Bureau's World-Wide Web site (<http://www.census.gov>). Once on the site, click on Subjects A-Z, then on Fertility.

All survey data are subject to sampling variability as well as survey design flaws, respondent classification errors, and data processing mistakes. The Census Bureau has taken steps to minimize errors. However, because of methodological differences, use caution when comparing these data with data from other sources. Note: Since the number of women who have had a birth during the 12-month period was tabulated and not the actual numbers of births themselves, a small underestimation of fertility for this period may exist because of the omission of: (1) Multiple births; (2) more than one live birth occurring to women in a 12-month period (the woman is counted only once); (3) women who had births in the period and who died by the survey date; (4) women who were in institutions and therefore not in the survey universe; and (5) 2 percent of births in a 12-month period (only 51 weeks of data are tabulated in the CPS due to the interview schedule). These losses may be somewhat offset by the inclusion in the CPS of births to immigrants who did not have their children born in the United States and births to nonresident women who had their children born in the U.S. These births would have not been recorded in the vital registration system. The ages of the women in this table and similar tables refer to the age of women at the time of the survey and not at the birth of their child.
