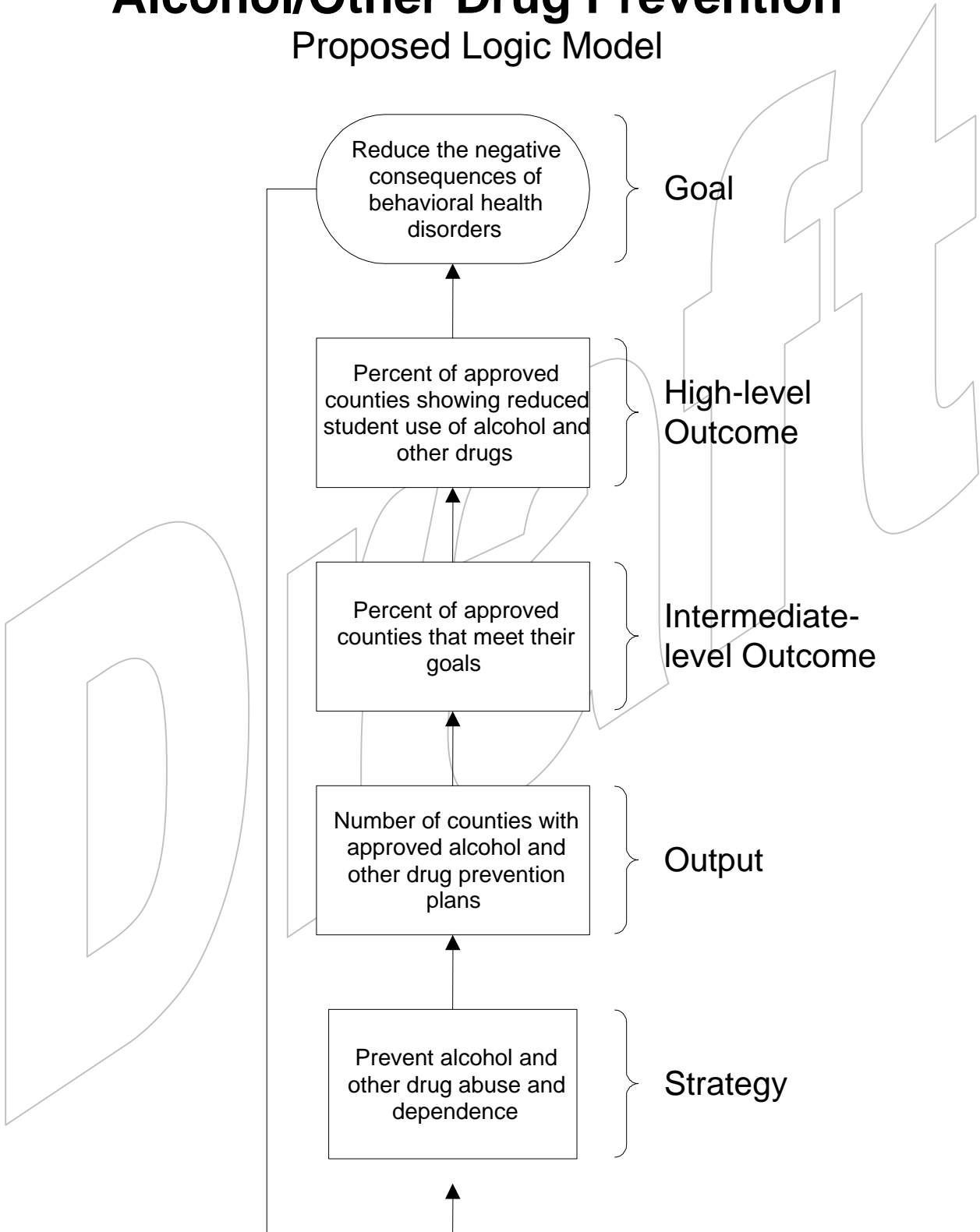


Alcohol/Other Drug Prevention Proposed Logic Model

The Measure	Description	Target	Why It's Important	Numerator/Denominator	Source of Data
Reduced Use	Percent of approved counties in which 8th and 11th grade students report decreased use of alcohol or other drugs	Increase	Student alcohol and other drug use is an early indicator of potential abuse and dependence	Numerator: Number of approved counties where the percent of students reporting alcohol or other drug use is at the same level, or lower than the previous year. Denominator: Number of approved counties.	Oregon Healthy Teens Survey

The Measure	Description	Target	Why It's Important	Numerator/Denominator	Source of Data
County goals	Percent of approved counties meeting the goals outlined in annual prevention implementation plans	Increase	Goal achievement indicates the county's plan is succeeding.	Numerator: Number of approved counties that meet their goals. Denominator: Number of approved counties.	Prevention Unit reports
