SOUTH VALLEY RESIDENTS INVITED TO COMMUNITY VISIONING SESSION

Bernalillo County Commissioner Teresa L. Cordova, PhD., cordially invites South Valley residents to attend a public “Community Visioning Session” to discuss how to develop a 4.5-acre tract of land that will serve as the “gateway” to their historic community.

The public meeting will be hosted by Commissioner Cordova, the Bernalillo County Parks and Recreation Department, and the Albuquerque Metropolitan Arroyo Flood Control Authority (AMAFCA). It will be held on Tuesday, October 3 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the South Valley Economic Development Center, 318 Isleta Blvd. SW.

The “South Valley Gateway Project” addresses vacant land at the southeast corner of Isleta and Bridge, former sites of La Familia and a McDonald’s restaurant. Bernalillo County and AMAFCA each own one of the properties and plan to conduct three “Community Visioning Sessions” to determine how it should be used.

“This is an opportunity for the community to help shape the development of a site that benefits the South Valley,” Commissioner Cordova says.
