

Hubbell House Alliance 2006 Membership Drive

The Hubbell House Alliance, in conjunction with Bernalillo County Parks and Recreation, is recruiting more volunteer members. Hubbell House Alliance is a non-profit organization formed to preserve Bernalillo County's Hubbell-Gutierrez House, an historic landmark in the South Valley. County Commissioner Teresa L. Cordova, Ph.D., will provide an update of reconstruction efforts at the event.

The membership drive will be held Sunday, October 1, 2006 at the Hubbell-Gutierrez House, 6029 Isleta Blvd, SW from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The Hubbell House Alliance will manage the Hubbell Demonstration Farm and Living History Museum, which will eventually be established at the Hubbell House. Bernalillo County purchased the house and property in November, 2000 and since then, the building has been going through a renovation process that maintains the integrity of the original structure.

When it is established, the Hubbell Demonstration Farm and Living History Museum will provide many benefits to the community including job training for South Valley youth, local history tutorials, economic development for small-scale sustainable agriculture and advocacy for organic farming methods.
