COMMISSION AWARDS CONTRACT FOR GUARD SERVICES

The Commission has awarded contract No. SECHQ1-92-C-0198 to AM-PRO Protective Agency, Inc. 7499 Parklane Road, Suite 136, Columbia, South Carolina 29224-3829 for guard services for the period May 1, 1992 through September 30, 1992 with four one-year options. Twenty-nine companies were solicited (RFP #SECHQ1-91-R-0018). Four proposals were received. The contract was awarded for a total of \$3,360,937.15 for a period of 53 months. The Contractor will provide all management, supervision, manpower, material, supplies, uniforms, and equipment (except otherwise provided by the agency). The Contractor will also plan, schedule, coordinate and assure effective performance of all security services to be provided at the Judiciary Plaza Building and the Securities and Exchange Commission's Operations Center located in Alexandria, VA.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ZWEIG TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Zweig Tax-Free Fund, Inc. (formerly DBL Tax-Free Fund, Inc.) for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18670 - April 22)

CYPRESS FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Cypress Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18671 - April 23)

ML LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting ML Life Insurance Company of New York, ML of New York Variable Life Separate Account II and Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c) and 27(c)(1) of the Act and Rules 6e-3(T) and 22c-1 thereunder. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a deferred premium tax charge upon the surrender of certain variable life insurance contracts. (Rel. IC-18672 - April 23)

ML LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK, ET AL.

An order has been issued to ML Life Insurance Company of New York, ML of New York Variable Life Separate Account II (Separate Account) and Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. (collectively, Applicants) for an order of the Commission pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order exempts the Applicants from Sections 12(d)(1), 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. Pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Act, the order also exempts the Applicants from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Act in connection with the use of certain unit investment trusts as investment vehicles of the Separate Account. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over and authorizing Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered public-utility holding company, to issue and sell up to 9,775,000 additional authorized but unissued common shares (Shares), \$5 par value in one or more issues. The Shares consist of up to 8.5 million Shares offered by Northeast to the public and up to 1,275,000 Shares that are subject to an over-allotment option held by the underwriters, which will entitle them to purchase these additional Shares at the same price. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over term borrowings and interim bank borrowings, if any, by Northeast; the issuance and sale by North Atlantic Energy Corporation, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Northeast, of up to \$355 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds, interim bank borrowings, if any, and short-term borrowings; and certain fees and expenses associated with the acquisition of Public Service of New Hampshire. MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company and West Penn Power Company (APS Companies), public-utility subsidiary companies of Allegheny Power System, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue secured solid waste disposal notes (Notes), at any time or from time to time on or before December 31, 1994. The Notes will be issued in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$20 million to support the issuance of solid waste disposal revenue bonds by the County Commission of Harrison County, West Virginia. In order to secure its obligations under the Notes, each of the APS Companies proposes to issue a second lien on its interest in the pollution control facilities. (Rel. 35-25522)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-07) to, among other things, discontinue the PSE's Lead Market Maker (LMM) Appointment Committee and create an Options Allocation Committee which will allocate, reallocate and evaluate options issues and monitor the performance of trading crowds and LMMs. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of April 27.
