CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE SUIT FILED AGAINST ZENOX, INC. AND OTHERS

The Commission announced that on February 11 the Commission filed a civil suit against Zenox, Inc., Richard G. English and Charles Ferguson in the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division, seeking injunctive relief, civil penalties and officer and director bars. The suit alleges that from 1989 through 1992, English and Ferguson, on behalf of Zenox, Inc., prepared and filed numerous untimely annual, quarterly and current reports with the Commission that were materially false and misleading, and disseminated press releases and a proxy statement that were false and misleading. Additionally, the Commission alleges that Zenox, Inc. did not make or keep accurate books and records and failed to establish and maintain adequate internal accounting controls. The suit alleges that the basis for the fraudulent filings is that Zenox, Inc. materially overstated its assets and stockholder's equity on many of its financial statements during this time period by overstating the value of its mergers and acquisitions. On numerous occasions, Zenox, Inc. overstated the value of assets that it had acquired in exchange for its stock. On other occasions, Zenox, Inc. included assets on its financial statements at a time when the acquisition transaction had not been completed. [SEC v. Richard G. NEIL LITVIN PERMANENTLY ENJOINED ON DEFAULT IN J.T. MORAN CASE

On February 2, the Honorable Thomas P. Griesa permanently enjoined defendant Neil Litvin (Litvin) on default, following Litvin's failure to answer the Securities and Exchange Commission's (Commission) complaint. Litvin was permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud, registration, antimanipulation, and margin provisions of the federal securities laws, and the margin provisions promulgated by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System.

The Commission filed its complaint on July 14, 1992, seeking permanent injunctive relief against six defendants, whom the Commission alleged engaged in numerous violations of the federal securities laws in connection with their association with J.T. Moran & Co., Inc. (Moran & Co.), a "boiler room" broker-dealer which ceased operations in January 1990.

The Commission's complaint alleged Litvin and others engaged in a trading scheme which falsely inflated Moran & Co.'s net capital for the months ending July through September 1988. The complaint also alleged that Litvin and others manipulated the market for MoranFin units following Moran & Co.'s October 1988 public offering of those securities. [SEC v. CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST DAVID KAGEL, MAGIC RESTAURANTS, INC., GARY ROGERS, STEPHEN ROGERS AND EDMOND NAGEL

On February 16, the Commission announced the filing of a complaint against David L. Kagel (Kagel) of Beverly Hills, California, and Magic Restaurants, Inc. (Magic Restaurants), Gary Rogers, Stephen Rogers and Edmond C. Nagel, all of the New York City area, seeking permanent injunctions against each of them prohibiting future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, and 13a-11 thereunder.

The complaint alleges that the defendants engaged in a fraudulent scheme to take their private restaurant business public by prearranging a merger with a shell company they created, misrepresenting in the shell company's S-18 registration statement that it had no agreements with potential merger candidates and subsequently failing to disclose the prearranged merger in Magic Restaurants' Form 8-K.

Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint the defendants, with the exception of Kagel, consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of Final Judgments permanently enjoining them from violations of the above provisions of the federal securities laws. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MFS LIFETIME GOLD & NATURAL RESOURCES FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by MFS Lifetime Gold & Natural Resources Fund, et al. for an order to amend certain prior orders under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The exemption would permit applicants to waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain additional redemptions of their shares. (Rel. IC-19266 - February 16)

NEUWIRTH FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Neuwirth Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19267 - February 17)

KIDDER PEABODY CALIFORNIA TAX EXEMPT MONEY FUND, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Kidder Peabody California Tax Exempt Money Fund, et al. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The conditional order permits certain investment companies to issue and sell multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same investment portfolio and assess and, under certain circumstances, waive or reduce a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of their shares. (Rel. IC-19269 - February 17)

SIEBEL CAPITAL PARTNERS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 15, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Siebel Capital Partners, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19270 - February 17)

PFL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.
