EXCHANGE COMMISSION

PROPOSED RULE 15b7-1

The Commission has authorized the publication of a release soliciting comment on proposed Rule 15b7-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The release proposes for comment a rule that would prohibit registered broker-dealers from effecting any securities transactions unless the associated person effecting such transaction is in compliance with the requirements established under the rules of any self-regulatory organization of which the broker-dealer is a member or to which it is subject.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DISGORGEMENT ORDERS ENTERED AGAINST 11 RELIEF DEFENDANTS

The Commission announced that on March 9 and 11 Orders of Disgorgement and Termination of Action were entered by consent against Relief Defendants Steven A. Elkow, Robert Ferber, Morris Fox, Edwin Hansen, Michael Harris, Michael Kelly, Brian Osgood, Executor of the Estate of Wilbur Payne, deceased, Terry Roggensack, Howard Stotler and Executors of the Estate of Kenneth W. Stotler, deceased. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, except personal jurisdiction and that subject matter jurisdiction had been found, the settling Relief Defendants consented to the entry of disgorgement orders which ordered them to relinquish any and all right, currently and previously held, title and beneficial interest in certain common stock and debentures of Stotler Group, Inc. (SGI) which were obtained as a partner of Stotler and Company, the Partnership and in connection with SGI's August 1988 initial public offering. The disgorgement orders further provide that the stock and debenture certificates will be deposited with the Clerk of the Court for cancellation.

The Commission's complaint included a Prayer for Relief against nineteen Relief Defendants for disgorgement of certain assets, monies and other properties to which the Relief Defendants allegedly had no legitimate claim. The Commission's action continues against the Defendants and remaining Relief Defendants. [SEC v. Thomas M. Egan, et al., 92 C 3480, ND Ill.] (LR-13574)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

LOUIS VARGAS SENTENCED

The U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California and the Commission announced that on March 16 Louis Vargas (Vargas), former president of First Securities Group of California, Inc. (First Securities) was sentenced to 71 months in prison in connection with a scheme to defraud investors through the sale of bogus municipal bonds. Vargas had previously pleaded guilty to an Information charging him with securities fraud in connection with his role in the scheme, and bank fraud in connection with his submission of a fraudulent loan package.

In a related civil case, a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief was entered on October 14, 1992 against FSG Financial Services, Inc. (FSG), the successor to First Securities, and FSG's president, Joan S. Kantor (SEC v. FSG Financial Services, Inc. and Joan S. Kantor, Civil Action No. 91-3960, JMI, JRx, CD Cal., LR-13422). [U.S. v. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-92-10) relating to DTC's proposal to add valued pledges and releases to its Next-Day Funds Settlement System. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-32004)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-92-35) that makes a clarifying change to OCC's By-laws and Rules to require U.S. broker-dealer applicants for membership and existing domestic clearing members to employ one associated person who is registered or qualified with the National Association of Securities Dealers as a "Limited Principal -- Financial and Operations." Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-32010)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSE-92-10) to establish rules allowing for and governing the trading of standardized baskets on the MSE floor and to seek Commission approval to trade a specific basket product on the MSE. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-32011)

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
