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## LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

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### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-34) that amends Article IX, Section 4 of the NASD By-Laws to conform the procedures for filing vacancies on Nominating Committees to those currently in place for District Committees. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32516)

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-93-13) to expand the cross-margining program between OCC and the Kansas City Board of Trade Clearing Corporation to include non-proprietary positions. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32533)

The Options Clearing Corporation and The Intermarket Clearing Corporation filed proposed rule changes (SR-OCC-92-28 and SR-ICC-92-5) relating to a cross-margining program among OCC, ICC and CME. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32534)

### TEMPORARY APPROVAL ON AN ACCELERATED BASIS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted approval on an accelerated basis, through June 30, 1994, to a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-93-14) filed by The Options Clearing Corporation regarding the revise standards for letters of credit which Clearing Members deposit as margin with OCC. (Rel. 34-32532)

### APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-93-4) to revise its By-Laws regarding indemnification of directors, officers and employees. The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-92-06) to amend its By-Laws to permit the same individual to serve simultaneously as Chairman and President of the CSE. (Rel. 34-32541)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-92-20) to permit a specialist, upon request of a member conducting a market probe, to disclose information regarding orders on the specialist's book which are at or near the prevailing quotation. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
