## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### JAMES FORS BARRED

The Commission instituted proceedings against James H. Fors (Fors) pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an offer of settlement from Fors in which he consented to the entry of an Order which makes findings that Fors violated Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by engaging in a scheme to distribute the unregistered stock of Micro-Books International, Inc., SouthCo Communications, Inc. and Walsh Communications Group, Inc. Fors sold these securities while making misrepresentations concerning the business condition of the issuers and omitting to state material facts concerning, among other things, the control Fors exercised over the stock of the three companies. Fors represented to most of the investors that the investors were buying stock in public companies when in fact the stock of the issuers was controlled by Fors and a small group of individuals.

The Commission ordered that Fors be barred from participating in an offering of penny stock. (Rel. 34-32662)

### LESTER BOYNICK, SARA GOLDMAN, REBECCA RIGGS AND DEBORAH TJOSVOLD BARRED

The Commission instituted proceedings against Lester Force Boynick, Sara Hall Goldman, Rebecca Riggs and Deborah Grace Tjosvold pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted offers of settlement from each respondent in which each consented to the entry of an Order without admitting or denying the findings contained therein. The Order makes findings that each respondent violated Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder by engaging in a scheme to distribute the unregistered stock of Micro-Books International, Inc., SouthCo Communications, Inc. and Walsh Communications Group, Inc. In addition, all respondents marketed the stock of Micro-Books, SouthCo and Walsh as if they were dealers registered with the Commission when, in fact, they were not. Finally, each respondent promoted the stock while misrepresenting material facts and omitting to state other material facts.

The Commission ordered that Boynick, Goldman, Riggs and Tjosvold be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, transfer agent or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-32663)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST CHARLES FERGUSON

The Commission announced that on July 22 Judge Robert L. Vining of U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia entered final judgment against Charles Ferguson (Ferguson). The Court permanently enjoined Ferguson from future violations of the federal securities laws, permanently barred him from serving as an officer or director of a public company and ordered him to pay \$7,000 in civil penalties. Ferguson consented to the entry of the judgment without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. Ferguson, a certified public accountant, was the Vice President of Finance\Operations and financial consultant for Zenox, Inc. In the suit filed against Ferguson, Zenox, Inc. and Richard English, president of Zenox, Inc., the Commission alleged that from 1989 through 1992 Ferguson, on behalf of Zenox, Inc., assisted in the preparation of numerous quarterly and several current reports with the Commission that were materially false and misleading. Additionally, during the time Ferguson worked for the company, Zenox failed to maintain adequate books and records or internal controls. The suit alleged that the filings of Zenox, Inc. materially overstated its assets and stockholders' equity on many of its financial statements by overstating the value of its mergers and acquisitions. ### PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF ISSUED AGAINST HOWARD BAER

The Commission announced today that on July 26 the Honorable Kimba J. Wood, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of New York, entered an Order of Preliminary Injunction and Other Equitable Relief on Consent (Order) against Howard R. Baer (Baer). The Order preliminarily enjoined Baer from further violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Order also froze Baer's assets and called for an accounting.

The complaint alleges that since June 1993, Baer engaged in a fraudulent scheme in which he placed trades through numerous broker-dealers to purchase the common stock of K-Fuel, Inc. (K-Fuel) without the intent or ability to pay for these trades. The complaint alleges that Baer made various material misrepresentations and omissions to these broker-dealers. Specifically, the complaint alleges that Baer omitted to tell the broker-dealers that he lacked the ability to pay for the securities purchased; falsely told the broker-dealers that funds were forthcoming to settle the trades; and falsely supplied the various broker-dealers with inconsistent and, therefore, inaccurate information regarding his net worth. The complaint alleges that as a result of Baer's fraudulent conduct, a number of the broker-dealers suffered losses which could total in excess of \$2.1 million. [SEC v. Howard R. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
