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## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### CHARLES D'ANGELO BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Charles D'Angelo, a former branch manager with Smith Barney, Harris Upham and Co., Inc., a registered broker-dealer. In anticipation of these proceedings, D'Angelo submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

Without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's Order for Public Proceedings, D'Angelo, in his offer of settlement, consented to findings that he wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities and Exchange Acts by misappropriating approximately \$800,000 from clients' accounts while employed by Smith Barney. D'Angelo also consented to the sanctions contained in the order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### PAINE WEBBER PROGRAMMED AMORTIZATION TERM SECURITIES, INC.

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### WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of PYRAMID MAGNETICS, INC. to withdraw its common stock (no par value) from listing and registration on the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (Rel. 34-21934)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by the American Stock Exchange, Inc. and the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-85-6; SR-CBOE-85-1) which would amend the respective policies of the exchanges to allow: \$2.50 strike price intervals for options overlying securities priced at or below \$25; and the introduction of new individual stock option series until the first calendar day of their expiration month. The Commission is also soliciting comment on the Amex filing. (Rel. 34-21929)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by: The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-85-5) which would amend NYSE Rule 703, Supplementary Material .30, regarding exercise prices and the opening of new options series. The Commission is also soliciting comment on the proposal. (Rel. 34-21931); (SR-NYSE-85-6) which would amend certain NYSE rules and policies concerning the trading of options on individual listed stocks and stock index options to conform to those of the other options exchanges. The Commission is also soliciting comment on the proposal. (Rel. 34-21932); and The American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-85-7) to permit specialists, traders and customers to enter opening transactions against closing cabinet bids or offers in certain circumstances. (Rel. 34-21936)

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO NASD FINGERPRINTING PLAN

The Commission is publishing for comment an amendment to the National Association of Securities Dealers' fingerprinting plan. The proposal would enable the NASD to return, on behalf of its members, microfilmed records of FBI-processed fingerprint cards that do not contain criminal history information. Comments should be submitted in triplicate to John Wheeler, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received 21 days after publication in the Federal Register and should refer to File No. 4-263. All submissions will be available for public inspection in the Public Reference Room. 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### HOUSEHOLD FINANCE CORPORATION

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Household Financial Corporation that the trusteeship of the First National Bank of Chicago (FNBC) under existing indentures and a new indenture is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify FNBC from acting as trustee under the new indenture.
