ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST FIRE SAFETY CORPORATION

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Act of 1933 in the matter of a securities registration statement filed by Fire Safety Corporation, a Delaware corporation with temporary offices in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The proceedings are based on allegations that Fire Safety's S-18 registration statement, filed on May 2, 1984, includes untrue statements of material fact and omits to state material facts concerning, among other things, the reliability of tests conducted on the company's proprietary system of fire retardant coatings.

Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement in which Fire Safety, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, consented to findings and entry of a Commission order which suspends the effectiveness of its registration statement and which requires it to comply with its undertaking to file an appropriate amendment to the registration statement correcting the material deficiencies set forth in the Commission's Order, and containing a narrative summary of the proceedings. PAN AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL ORDERED TO AMEND REGISTRATION STATEMENT

The Commission entered Findings and an Order against Pan American International, Inc. (PAI) of Aurora, Colorado. PAI consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's Order for Proceedings [Rel. 34-21278, August 30, 1984]. The Order requires PAI to amend its Form 10 registration statement and to restate its financial statements included therein within 60 days.

The allegations against PAI were: (a) that PAI's Form 10 registration statement included improper accounting treatments involving the write-up of assets following a business combination, omitted to state facts respecting PAI's president's connection with the prior bankruptcy of another company, failed to include a required audited financial statement; and (b) that PAI also failed to file periodic reports required by Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act subsequent to its registration. COLLATERALIZED MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORPORATION; SALOMON CAPITAL ASSETS CORPORATION

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until May 20 and May 21, respectively, to request a hearing on an application filed by Collateralized Mortgage Securities Corporation and Salomon Capital Access Corporation for an order exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Cincinnati Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The rule change (SR-CSE-85-2) increases exchange dues of all proprietary members from \$900 to \$1,500, payable quarterly, rather than semi-annually. (Rel. 34-21969)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
