## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

### FORM N-7 PROPOSED FOR COMMENT

The Commission proposes for public comment Form N-7, a new form for registration of unit investment trusts and their securities under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933, and related rules and rule amendments. The Commission is also publishing staff guidelines for the preparation of Form N-7.

### AMENDMENTS TO FORM 13F ADOPTED

The Commission adopted amendments to Form 13F under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The amendments simplify the procedures for requesting confidential treatment of certain risk arbitrage positions reported on the form and limit the time for which confidential treatment of commercial information may be requested. ### COMMENTS REQUESTED ON A REVISION OF RULE 70 AND AMENDMENTS TO RULE 50

The Commission proposes for public comment a revision of Rule 70 and amendments to Rule 50 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. The proposed rule revision would permit a limited number of investment bankers and commercial bankers to serve as officers or directors of public utility holding companies and their subsidiaries under certain conditions. The proposed action is intended to simplify, clarify and expand the exemptions now available under the existing rule. The proposed amendments to Rule 50 would address potential conflicts of interest which might arise shortly after an affiliated person of an investment banker leaves the board of directors of a company in a holding company if that investment banker plays a significant role in the distribution of the securities of any company in the same system.

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-85-4) that amends the definition of "representative" in Schedule C of the NASD's By-Laws. As amended, the term "representative" would include persons who are employed by certain non-broker/dealer organizations, who solicit and receive business for a member, and who receive compensation from a member for such services or their employers receive compensation. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 13. (Rel. 34-22034)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Municipal Securities Rule-making Board under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSRB-85-9) requiring that transactions in certain tax-exempt securities that are sold at issuance at a discount from the par amount shall be designated as original issue discount securities on confirmations. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
