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### PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO RULE 15Bc7-1

The Commission requests comments on a proposed amendment to Rule 15Bc7-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to permit the availability of composite compliance examination information to the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board.

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### VAN CLEEF, JORDAN AND WOOD AND RICHARD F.F. NICHOLS SUBMIT OFFERS OF SETTLEMENT

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted by Van Cleef, Jordan and Wood (of Connecticut) (VCJW) and Richard F.F. Nichols in settlement of administrative proceedings brought against them on October 3, 1983 in their activities as investment adviser to the Greenfield Fund, Inc. (Fund). As part of the Offer, Respondents, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Commission findings that they violated and aided and abetted violations of the securities laws in calculating net asset value of shares of the Fund as well as the recordkeeping and pricing provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940.

Respondents consented to an Order suspending VCJW's registration as an investment adviser for 30 days and suspending Nichols from being associated with VCJW for that period. In addition, VCJW and Nichols agreed to undertakings, among other things, whereby they will: (1) maintain accurate and current books and records relating to the Fund's operation and comply with all applicable rules and regulations under the securities laws; and (2) provide the Commission staff with an unqualified opinion by the Fund's auditor that its books and records are being kept in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. ### JEAN-PAUL GRAVELL'S INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION REVOKED AND GRAVELL BARRED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Jean-Paul Gravelle for violations of the Advisers Act and the Securities Act of 1933 while registered with the Commission as an investment adviser individually and doing business as Bras D'Or Inc.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that Gravelle wilfully violated: Section 204 of the Advisers Act and Rule 204-1(c), by failing to file annual reports; Section 5(c) of the Securities Act, by offering to sell to members of the public unregistered securities in the form of limited partnership interests; and Section 206(2) of the Advisers Act, by engaging in transactions, practices or courses of business which operated as a fraud or deceit upon prospective clients, specifically, circulating to approximately 200 prospective investors and prospective clients an offering statement containing material misrepresentations and omissions regarding, among other things, the existence and performance of a bond fund, and the enforcement of a securities offering by a major brokerage firm.

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement in which Gravelle, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the Order revoking his registration as an investment adviser and barring him from any association with any investment adviser. (Rel. IA-972)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### CONNECTICUT MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 24 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to borrow \$50 million to construct generating facilities, and requesting an exception from competitive bidding. (Rel. 35-23709 - May 28)

### CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 21 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, for Consolidated to incur short-term debt and for Consolidated and the subsidiaries to engage in intrasystem financing. Consolidated proposes to make short-term borrowings of up to \$175 million from banks to: sell commercial paper in an amount not exceeding \$300 million or to issue and sell notes under a revolving credit agreement of up to \$125 million at one time outstanding if the sale of commercial paper proves impractical; make open account advances to subsidiaries not exceeding \$464.1 million; make long-term loans to subsidiaries of up to \$182.5 million; make revolving credit advances to subsidiaries not exceeding \$100; and purchase up to \$72.7 million par value of capital stock of subsidiaries. ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Midwest Stock Exchange Inc. (SR-MSE-85-3) to amend its Article XX, Rule 1, Interpretations and Policies .01, Section I, relating to Specialist Assignment and Evaluation. The amendment would establish procedures for the semi-annual posting of issues assigned to co-specialists in which MSE ranks below three or more other exchanges in terms of market share. (Rel. 34-22077); and The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-85-17) to modify its Rule 412, governing customer securities account transfers, to require that account transfers occur within ten days. (Rel. 34-22080)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS AND ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. refiled proposed amendments to its NMS Designation Plan under Rule 11Aa2-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Commission approved the amendments on a temporary basis for 120 days. (Rel. 34-22082)

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-85-6) allowing the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. to become an OCC Participating Exchange and making other rule changes enabling OCC to issue, clear and settle options on National Market System stocks. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
