EXTENSION OF COMPLIANCE DATE FOR FOREIGN CUSTODY ARRANGEMENTS; PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 17f-5

The Commission extended until September 1, 1985 the date by which investment companies must conform their foreign custody arrangements to the requirements of Rule 17f-5 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. The Commission also proposed amendments to Rule 17f-5 that would clarify how the eligibility of foreign custodians should be determined, the extent to which investment companies must monitor foreign custodian eligibility and the length of time that investment companies have to make alternative arrangements when an existing foreign custody arrangement no longer complies with the rule.

Comments on the proposed rule amendments should be submitted in triplicate to John Wheeler, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received on or before 30 days from publication of the release in the Federal Register and should refer to File No. S7-25-85. All submissions will be available for public inspection in the Public Reference Room. (Rel. IC-14548)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

INITIAL DECISION LIMITS OPERATIONS OF ROONEY PACE; SUSPENDS RANDOLPH PACE

Administrative Law Judge Max O. Regensteiner issued an initial decision in proceedings respecting Rooney, Pace Inc., a New York City broker-dealer, and Randolph Pace, its president. The decision prohibits the firm for two months from entering into any underwriting commitments and for an additional four months from entering into an underwriting commitment involving a conditional offering. Pace is suspended from association with a broker-dealer for three months. These sanctions were based on findings that the firm and Pace violated antifraud provisions in a 1981 "best efforts all or none" offering of securities of Sequential Information Systems.

The initial decision is subject to Commission review on petition of a party or on the Commission's own initiative.

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST STEPHEN G. KARANZALIS

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Stephen G. Karanzalis of New York, New York, formerly a registered representative of three broker-dealers registered with the Commission.

The Order of Public Proceedings contains findings that between late 1982 and March 1984, Karanzalis wilfully violated the antifraud and tender offer provisions of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 in his involvement in a scheme to misappropriate and trade on confidential, material non-public information from the New York City law firm of Skadden Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom.

Simultaneously with the institution of proceedings, the Commission accepted Karanzalis' Offer of Settlement whereby he consented to a Commission order: (1) containing the findings outlined above and a finding that he has been permanently enjoined from further violations of the aforesaid provisions in SEC v. Stephen G. Karanzalis, 84 Civil 2070 (CLB) (SDNY); and (2) barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. **ALLIED SECURITIES CORPORATION CENSURED;
JACK LIPPMAN SUSPENDED**

The Commission simultaneously instituted public administrative proceedings and imposed sanctions against Allied Securities Corporation, a Lauderhill, Florida securities broker-dealer, and Jack Lippman, Allied's president, compliance officer and principal financial officer. The respondents consented to the findings and sanctions without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings.

The Commission found that from about June 30 through August 17, 1984, Allied, aided and abetted by Lippman, wilfully violated the broker liquidity, recordkeeping and filing provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules thereunder, by failing to: maintain net capital of not less than \$5,000; maintain accurate books and records; and give immediate telegraphic notice of such net capital and bookkeeping violations. Inaccurate financial reports were also filed with the NASD.

The Commission's sanctions included a: censure of Allied; suspension of Lippman from association with any broker or dealer for one year; and bar of Lippman from functioning as a compliance officer or assuming responsibility for bookkeeping or recordkeeping functions or for the filing of financial reports, on behalf of any broker or dealer. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DREYFUS TAX EXEMPT CASH MANAGEMENT, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by Dreyfus Tax Exempt Cash Management, Inc. for an order exempting it from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act to permit it to acquire rights to sell its portfolio securities to broker-dealers. SOURCE CAPITAL, INC.

An order has been issued permitting Source Capital, Inc. to repurchase shares of its common and preferred stock from those shareholders who own less than 40 shares at a premium of up to \$1.00 per share in excess of the market price of such shares. (Rel. IC-14549 - May 31)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Mississippi Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue a promissory note to the City of Gulfport, Mississippi, to finance the restoration of a historic office building in the City of Gulfport. (Rel. 35-23713 - May 31)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

**ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES;
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES**

The Commission granted accelerated approval of proposed rule changes filed by The American Stock Exchange, Inc. and The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-85-12; SR-NYSE-85-18) to amend their rules that act as barriers to multiple trading of options on over-the-counter stocks. The Commission also approved proposed rule changes filed by Amex and NYSE (SR-Amex-85-33; SR-NYSE-84-4) to trade options on certain National Market System stocks. (Rel. 34-22094-Amex; 34-22098-NYSE)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The rule change (SR-CBOE-85-20) establishes a deposit requirement for leased memberships of CBOE. (Rel. 34-22096)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

FIRST BANK SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by First Bank System, Inc. that the trusteeship of Chemical Bank under an existing First Bank indenture and the trusteeship of Chemical Bank as successor trustee under an indenture between First Bank and Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify Chemical Bank from acting as trustee under either of such indentures. MISCELLANEOUS

FIDELITY MANAGEMENT & RESEARCH COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Fidelity Management & Research Company's advisory fee arrangement with a limited partnership to be established by it from the prohibitions of Section 205(1) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The order also exempts Fidelity from the recordkeeping requirements of Section 204 and Rules 204-2(b) and (c) under the Act, and granting confidential treatment to the Limited Partnership Agreement filed with the application.
