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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### CLIFFORD MURRAY BARRED

The Commission barred Clifford R. Murray, a former Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc. (DWR) registered representative, from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer. Murray consented to the bar.

Murray, while employed at DWR's Atlantic City, New Jersey branch office, converted approximately \$4 million of customer's funds through unauthorized liquidations of their accounts. In an effort to conceal his conversion, Murray disseminated false and misleading information to these customers regarding the identities and value of their securities holdings.

In August 1984, Murray was convicted in the Superior Court of Atlantic County Court House, New Jersey, upon his plea of guilty to theft charges based on the above culpable conduct and was subsequently sentenced to ten years imprisonment. In November 1984, Murray pled guilty in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey to an Information charging him with two counts of mail fraud in the same scheme and subsequently was sentenced to five years on each count, the sentences to run concurrently. ### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ANDERSON & STRUDWICK, INC., OTHERS

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Anderson & Strudwick, Inc. (Registrant), of Richmond, Virginia, a registered broker-dealer, George W. Anderson, its president, and J. Douglas Gordon, Jr., its vice-president and secretary-treasurer. The respondents submitted Offers of Settlement consenting to an Order which finds that, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Order, they willfully violated and wilfully aided and abetted violations of Sections 17(a)(2) and 17(a)(3) of the Securities Act of 1933 (antifraud provisions), Section 15B(c)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (violations of Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board Rules), and MSRB Rules G-17 (fair dealing) and G-30 (fair pricing). The proceedings are based on undisclosed excessive markups charged to customers in retail municipal bond transactions.

The Commission ordered that: Gordon be prohibited from engaging in municipal bond transactions for 20 business days; Registrant and Anderson be censured; Registrant repay customers \$30,285, representing the amount of excessive markups; and Registrant review its procedures to ensure the fairness of prices charged to customers. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST ELMAS TRADING CORPORATION, OTHERS

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on May 24 Judge Edward C. Reed, Jr., U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada, Reno Division, entered a Temporary Restraining Order and other ancillary relief against Elmas Trading Corporation, Republic Overseas Bank, Ltd., James L. Attarian and Donald D. Smith, restraining them from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and freezing certain of the defendants' assets. The Court also appointed a temporary receiver over Elmas and Republic. The defendants consented to the Orders without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The complaint alleges, among other things, that: since August 1982, the defendants have raised at least \$55 million from approximately 2,700 investors in 41 states by the fraudulent offer and sale of unregistered investment contracts in a commodities arbitrage trading program which promised returns to investors of 36% to 41.15% per year; a network of approximately 450 commissioned sales agents solicited sales of the securities; and the defendants misrepresented to investors the true risks of the trading program, the use of proceeds from sales of the securities, and the sources of funds used by pay returns to investors. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change filed by The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-83-61) to revise its rule concerning precedence for facilitation orders. (Rel. 34-22102)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES/ APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval of proposed rule changes filed by: The Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. and The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-85-13; SR-CBOE-85-17) to amend their rules that act as barriers to multiple trading of options on over-the-counter stocks. The Commission also approved PSE/CBOE proposed rule changes (SR-PSE-84-2; SR-CBOE-83-53) to trade options on certain National Market System stocks. (Rel. 34-22103; 34-22104)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
