CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PAPAHO CORP., OTHERS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on October 29 an Order of Permanent Injunction was entered against Papaho Corp., Paul H. Byus, Pauline F. Byus and Michael D. Byus enjoining them from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. The defendants consented to the order without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

The complaint alleges that the defendants raised over \$6 million from approximately 1,000 investors through the offer and sale of unregistered investment contracts and used the funds in the operation of a ponzi scheme. The complaint further alleges that the defendants failed to disclose material facts to investors including: (1) the risks of an investment; (2) that returns reported to investors were not in fact earned; (3) that returns paid to investors were paid with the principal of other investors; and (4) that the defendants paid personal expenses with investors' funds. QADRANT CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on November 1 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Qadrant Corporation of Golden, Colorado. The Judgment restrained and enjoined Qadrant from filing late or failing to file Annual and Quarterly Reports and Notifications of Late Filing.

In the July 30 complaint, the Commission alleged that Qadrant, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended September 30, 1984, and its Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended December 31, 1984, and March 31 and June 30, 1985, and failed to file or filed late certain Annual and Quarterly Reports and Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25. Qadrant, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it filed late or failed to file 15 Annual and Quarterly Reports and Notifications of Late Filing. (SEC v. Qadrant Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-2430). (LR-10926)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA ALASKAN GAS TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Columbia Alaskan Gas Transmission Corporation, to recapitalize the subsidiary and to have the subsidiary pay a dividend to the parent. (Rel. 35-23893 - Nov. 5)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-26) to amend Appendix F to Article III, Section 34 of its Rules of Fair Practice. The amendment would establish a safe harbor provision. Under the amendment, compensation received by an affiliate of an NASD member will not be deemed to be received in connection with or related to a public offering of a direct participation program if the affiliate complies with new criteria specified in Section 5(d)(1) of Appendix F. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
