## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### FEE RATE ADVISORY - NOVEMBER 10 UPDATE

The current continuing resolution has been extended. As a result of this extension, the fee rate for Section 6(b) filings will remain at the current rate of 1/33rd of one percent of the aggregate offering amount. This fee is calculated by dividing the aggregate offering amount by 3300.

This rate will be in effect until the pending appropriations bill is enacted or another continuing resolution is enacted. When the pending appropriations bill is enacted, the fee rate will be decreased to \$295 per \$1,000,000 (pro rated for amounts less than \$1,000,000). This fee will be calculated by multiplying the aggregate offering amount by .000295.

The Commission will issue further notices as appropriate to keep filers and registrants informed of developments affecting the Section 6(b) fee rate. ## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

---

### PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIVE AND CEASE AND DESIST PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST RUSSO SECURITIES, INC., PATRICK RUSSO AND KIMBERLY KENT

On November 7, the Commission instituted public administrative and cease and desist proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Russo Securities, Inc., (Russo), Patrick Russo (P. Russo), and Kimberly Kent (Kent).

In the order instituting proceedings (Order), the Commission's Division of Enforcement alleges that on December 29, 1995, January 31, 1996, February 29, 1996 and March 22, 1996, Russo, a broker-

dealer registered with the Commission, and a member of the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. and the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., willfully violated Section 15(c)(3) of the Exchange Act and Rule 15c3-1 in that it effected transactions in customer accounts without maintaining the required minimum net capital. The Commission's Division of Enforcement also alleges that Russo willfully violated Section 17(a)(1) of the Exchange Act and Rules 17a-3(a)(2), 17a-3(a)(11), 17a-5(a) and 17a-11 in that Russo made inaccurate records and filed inaccurate reports of its assets and net capital computations, and failed to provide the Commission with the required notices of its net capital and books and records deficiencies. Last, the Commission's Division of Enforcement alleges that P. Russo, one of the firm's owners and its president, and Kent, the firm's financial and operations principal and chief financial officer, each willfully aided and abetted, and was a cause of, Russo's violations described above. IN THE MATTER OF KENNETH O'NEAL, CPA, DONALD WHITE, CPA, AND GEORGE BLEIER, CPA

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against accountants Kenneth O'Neal, Donald White, and George Christopher Bleier and issued an Order denying them the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission. The Commission found that the respondents, who were licensed by the State of Texas as certified public accountants and employed by the firm of O'Neal & White, participated in deficient audits of Members Service Corporation's financial statements for the years ended December 31, 1991 and December 31, 1992. The respondents consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings.

The Commission found that O'Neal willfully violated Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder and engaged in improper professional conduct, and that White and Bleier engaged in improper professional conduct. The Order denies O'Neal, White, and Bleier the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission as accountants pursuant to Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. The Order provides that, after three years, Bleier may apply to the Commission for permission to appear or practice before the Commission. (Rel. 34-39314; AAE Rel. 983; File No. 3-9485)

ACACIA NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act, on an application filed by Acacia National Life Insurance Company, Acacia National Life Insurance Company Variable Life Separate Account I and Acacia National Life Insurance Company Variable Annuity Separate Account II, approving the substitution of

shares of the Neuberger & Berman Advisors Management Trust Limited Maturity Bond Portfolio for shares of the Strong Advantage Fund II and the substitution of shares of Acacia Capital Corporation Calvert Responsibly Invested Balanced Portfolio for shares of the Strong Asset Allocation Fund II. ### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-97-57) to change its rule to permit a FLEX equity option to have a term of five years in certain circumstances. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 10. (Rel. 34-39305)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-97-37) to include additional physically separate locations on the trading floor where options on Amex-listed stocks may trade. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 10. (Rel. 34-39306)

The Chicago Stock Exchange filed a proposed a rule change (SR-CHX-97-21) regarding suitability of customer recommendations. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register the week of November 10. (Rel. 34-39307)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Government Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-GSCC-97-06) that will amend GSCC's rules to establish an automatic debit arrangement for netting members' payment of funds-only settlement amounts to GSCC. The Commission has approved the proposed rule change on an accelerated basis. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 10. (Rel. 34-39309)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Exchange (SR-PCX-97-40) relating to a fee change for ASAP members has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 10. (Rel. 34-39311)
