ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

EDWARD MORRIS AND STEVEN GARDNER ARE EACH SENTENCED TO 46 MONTHS IN PRISON AND FINED \$10,000

The Commission and W. Charles Grace, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Illinois, announced that on July 8 the Honorable William Beatty, United States District Court Judge for the Southern District of Illinois, sentenced Edward L. Morris (Morris) and Steven M. Gardner (Gardner) each to 46 months in prison and fined them each \$10,000. The sentences are the result of Morris' and Gardner's convictions of three counts each of mail and wire fraud in connection with the offer and sale of \$10 million worth of subordinated capital notes issued by Germania Bank (Germania).

The sentences are for essentially the same conduct as is alleged in the Commission's complaint against Morris, Gardner, Joseph L. Mason, Jimmie W. New, and others which was filed in the Eastern District of Missouri on December 10, 1991. The Commission's complaint alleges that Morris and Gardner rejected an internal analysis recommending that Germania increase its existing reserves for losses on loan and other assets of approximately \$9.5 million by an additional amount of approximately \$9 million, and that Germania recorded a provision for losses on loans and other assets of only \$1.2 million for the quarter ended September 30, 1987.

Morris and Gardner were convicted of engaging in a fraudulent scheme which included failing to disclose the existence of the analysis, and failing to record a substantial portion of the reserves recommended in the analysis, which resulted in false and misleading information concerning Germania's financial condition being presented to investors. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-94-12) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange which amends the eligibility standards under which individuals, member organizations and joint accounts may participate in the CBOE's Retail Automatic Execution System (RAES) for Standard & Poor's 100 Index (OEX) options. Among other things, the proposal amends CBOE Rule 24.17, "RAES Eligibility in OEX" to replace the current \$500.00 fee for failing to comply with CBOE Rule 24.17's log-on and log-off requirements with the following fee schedule: a fee of \$100.00 for one to three failures within one calendar year; a fee of \$250.00 for four to six failures within one calendar year; and a fee of \$500.00 for seven or more failures within one calendar year. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 18. (Rel. 34-34376)
