COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ELAINE CACHERIS NAMED ASSOCIATE REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR IN LOS ANGELES

Los Angeles Regional Administrator James L. Sanders announced the appointment of Elaine M. Cacheris as Associate Regional Administrator for Enforcement. Ms. Cacheris joined the Commission's staff in November 1984 as an enforcement attorney in the Fort Worth Regional Office and in January 1987 transferred to the Los Angeles Regional Office. In June 1987 she was appointed to the position of Special Counsel-Enforcement and became a Branch Chief in Enforcement in January 1988. Before joining the Commission's staff she was an Assistant Attorney General for the State of Texas.

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

James R. Doty, General Counsel of the Securities and Exchange Commission, announced today that the Solicitor General, on behalf of the Commission, has filed a friend-of-the-court brief in the Supreme Court in *Kamen v. Kemper Financial Services, Inc.*, No. 90-516. The case concerns allegations by a shareholder of a mutual fund that the fund's investment adviser and manager violated the proxy solicitation provision of the Investment Company Act. The complaint sought damages to be paid to the fund.

The court of appeals affirmed the district court's dismissal of the proxy claim on the ground that, as a matter of federal law, shareholders must make demand for action by the directors in all derivative suits -- that is, in all suits brought by a shareholder on behalf of a corporation -- regardless of whether demand would be futile.

The Commission's brief argues that the claim that a misleading proxy statement was used to solicit shareholder votes is a direct shareholder action that does not implicate the requirement of demand applicable to derivative actions. The brief also argues that, on the assumption that a proxy action is derivative, the court of appeals erred in formulating a universal demand requirement as a matter of federal common law. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST GUIDO ECHEVARRIA, SR.

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on December 21, 1990 the Honorable James W. Kehoe, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief against Guido A. Echevarria, Sr. (Echevarria), of Coral Gables, Florida. Echevarria was an officer and director of Vista Management, Inc. (Vista) and Ventra Management, Inc. (Ventra), which operated from offices located in Hialeah, Florida.

The Final Judgment enjoins Echevarria from violating the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Final Judgment also requires Echevarria to make an accounting of funds raised by Vista and Ventra and to disgorge all ill-gotten proceeds. Echevarria consented to the entry of the Final Judgment, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint.

The complaint alleges that between approximately April 1986 and November 1989, Echevarria filed or caused to be filed periodic reports with the Commission which contained untrue statements of material facts or omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, Vista and Ventra's assets, revenues and equity, and the status of Vista and Ventra's ongoing business operations. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ADVANCE ROSS CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 15, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Advance Ross Corporation for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting it from all provisions of the Act until May 27, 1991 to enable it to consummate an acquisition or take other appropriate action so as to cease being an investment company under the Act. (Rel. IC-17955 - January 22)

INDUSTRIAL SERIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 19, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Industrial Series Trust, The Mackenzie Funds Inc., Mackenzie Investment Management Inc. and Mackenzie Financial Corporation for an order pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit the operation of a joint trading account in repurchase agreements. PILGRIM SHORT-TERM MULTI-MARKET INCOME FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 19, 1991 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pilgrim Short-Term Multi-Market Income Fund, Pilgrim Strategic Investment Series and Pilgrim Distributors Corp. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to permit the applicants to impose a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on redemptions of its shares and to waive the CDSC under certain circumstances. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Louisiana Power & Light Company, a subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, to acquire nuclear fuel by lease in amounts of up to \$160 million. (Rel. 35-25246)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-90-37) to expand its Post Execution Reporting (PER) system and its Options Switching (AMOS) system to increase the size of eligible market and limit orders. Specifically, PER market orders will be increased from 2,000 to 3,000 shares (and may be increased to 5,000 shares after six months at the discretion of AMEX), PER limit orders will be increased from 2,000 to 5,000 shares and AMOS market and limit orders will be increased from 20 to 30 option contracts. Publication of the release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 28. (Rel. 34-28813)
