ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DECISION BARRING WALTER CURRAN FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Walter F. Curran of Morgantown, West Virginia from association with any broker or dealer has become final. Curran was formerly a sales representative of Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc. in Boston.

The law judge found that, in 1989, Curran was convicted, on the basis of his guilty plea, of obtaining money from investors on the basis of false representations. Instead of investing the money, Curran converted it to his personal use. The law judge further found that Curran was also convicted of violating federal currency reporting laws by knowingly transporting over \$130,000 into the United States from Canada and willfully failing to file the required report disclosing that fact. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALEX. BROWN CASH RESERVE FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 5 to request a hearing on an application filed by Alex. Brown Cash Reserve Fund, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to permit certain investment companies to impose a contingent deferred sales load and to waive the load in certain instances. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Participants Trust Company (SR-PTC-91-06) under Rule 19b-4 to modify PTC's By-Laws to increase the number of directors on the Board of Directors from ten to twelve. The rule change also makes a technical modification to the By-Laws to clarify that the number of directors may be changed by either the directors or the shareholders. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 8. (Rel. 34-29403)
