INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Adirondack Income Shares, Inc., Allegheny Income Shares, Inc. and Humboldt Income Shares, Inc. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rels. IC-18235; IC-18236 and IC-18237 - July 11)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of the three exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 2 issues; Pacific Stock Exchange - 33 issues; and Midwest Stock Exchange - 1 issue. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by the following under Rule 19b-4: Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-91-10) relating to OCC's financial responsibility rules; and Participant Trust Company (SR-PTC-91-09) to authorize PTC to join the Securities Clearing Group, an association of clearing agency self-regulatory organizations. Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rels. 34-29429 and 34-24932, respectively)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-91-05) which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. The rule change accommodates the step-out service of the New York Stock Exchange. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-29431)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
