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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES  
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

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### CHICAGO REGIONAL OFFICE RELOCATION

The Chicago Regional Office of the Commission will relocate to new offices on December 2, 1991. After that date, all correspondence to the Chicago Regional Office should be addressed to Northwestern Atrium Center, 500 West Madison Street, Suite 1400, Chicago, Illinois 60661-2511. The telephone number of the Chicago Regional Office will remain (312) 353-7390. In view of the move, the Chicago Regional Office's Public Reference Room will close at 5:00 p.m., November 26, 1991 and reopen in the new office space on December 3, 1991.

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### EMPIRE FIDELITY INVESTMENTS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Empire Fidelity Investments Life Insurance Company, Empire Fidelity Investments Variable Annuity Account A (Account) and Fidelity Brokerage Services, Inc. from Sections 22(d), 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account under certain deferred variable annuity contracts and the waiver of the contingent deferred sales charge under the contracts in certain circumstances. (Rel. IC-18413 - November 21)

### SMITH BARNEY L.P. ESC-1, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting certain limited partnerships and their general partners from most provisions of the Act and permitting certain affiliated and joint transactions. Each limited partnership will be an employees' securities company as defined in the Act. (Rel. IC-18414 - November 21)

### FOX FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Fox Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18415 - November 21)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, to make such capital contributions to EUA Cogenex Corporation (Cogenex), a subsidiary company of EUA, as are necessary to maintain the levels of capitalization of Cognex required by an Equity Maintenance Agreement. The Equity Maintenance Agreement is between EUA and The Prudential Insurance Company of America (Prudential). EUA is also authorized to make such other payments to Prudential as may be required under the terms of Sections 2(b) and 4 of the Equity Maintenance Agreement. (Rel. 35-25412)

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## LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

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### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES AND WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 12 to comment on the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in seven over-the-counter issues: Comcast Corp., Corestates Financial Corp., Immunex Corporation, Safeco Corp. and U.S. Bancorp. The notice also gives interested persons until December 12 to comment on an application by the Exchange to withdraw unlisted trading privileges in two over-the-counter issues: Cetus Corporation and Quantum Corporation. ### DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration First Federal Bancorp, Inc., Common Stock, Par Value 1¢. (Rel. 34-29980)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-91-37) under Rule 19b-4 to amend its arbitration rules. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 25. (Rel. 34-29975)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-49) under Rule 19b-4 to amend Part III, Sections 12, 13(h), 22, 29 and 41(h) of the NASD Code of Arbitration Procedure to improve the efficiency of its arbitration process. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 25. (Rel. 34-29976)

The Delta Government Options Corp. filed a proposed rule change (SR-DGOC-91-03) under Rule 19b-4 relating to the definition of exercise price. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 25. (Rel. 34-29977)

**ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE**

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-60) submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers that would extend the OTC Bulletin Board pilot period through March 31, 1992. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 25. (Rel. 34-29979)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
