U.S. SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION

RITA BASKIN BARRED; REGISTRATION OF BASKIN PLANNING CONSULTANTS, LTD. REVOKED

The Commission today announced the issuance of an Order finding that on November 13 the Honorable Leonard D. Wexler, U.S. District Court Judge for the Eastern District of New York, permanently enjoined Baskin Planning Consultants, Ltd. (Baskin Planning) and Rita Baskin from further violating the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Commission's complaint, upon which the injunction was based, alleged that between 1983 and 1985 Baskin Planning and Rita Baskin sold unregistered securities issued by Broadhollow Funding Corporation (Broadhollow). Broadhollow held itself out as a real estate mortgage broker but actually operated a Ponzi scheme. The complaint further alleged that representatives of Baskin Planning, including Rita Baskin, failed to adequately investigate Broadhollow before selling its securities to clients; made materially false and misleading statements concerning Broadhollow; failed to disclose the receipt of commissions from Broadhollow; and failed to disclose a \$50,000 unsecured loan to Rita Baskin from Broadhollow. COMPLAINT AGAINST DONALD WRIGHT AND KENNETH KIMURA

On December 5, the Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Donald W. Wright and Kenneth Y. Kimura. The complaint alleges that Wright violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-9 thereunder. The complaint also alleges that Kimura violated Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-9 thereunder in connection with the closing of the initial public offering of Nevatech Industries, Inc.

The Commission alleges that during the period June through August 1988, Wright and Kimura, the Chairman and President of Nevatech, respectively, attempted to close Nevatech's mini-max initial public offering by entering into an arrangement whereby a Swiss Bank would purchase the required minimum number of shares in exchange for a guaranty against any loss incurred in reselling the shares. This guaranty was backed by a pledge of certain shares in a publicly traded company owned by Wright and other assets held by Kimura to D.G. Bank. Wright and Kimura consented to permanent injunctions. [SEC v. Donald W. Wright and Kenneth Y. Kimura, Civil Action No. 91-3114-JGP, D.D.C.] (LR-13110)

On December 5, the Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against Ray H. Kobayashi, G. Alfred Roensch, Donald W. Wright and Johanna Bachmann. The complaint alleges that the defendants violated Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 in connection with the illegal sale of 346,120 shares of unregistered American Aircraft Corporation stock during the period May through July 1988. These sales did not satisfy the holding period requirements of Rule 144.

Roensch issued two separate opinion letters which stated that the American Aircraft shares sold by the defendants were freely tradeable. When Roensch issued his second favorable opinion letter, he was aware that American Aircraft's outside counsel had previously withdrawn an opinion letter supporting the free tradeability of the stock. Roensch, Wright and Bachmann consented to permanent injunctions. [SEC v. Ray H. Kobayashi, G. Alfred Roensch, Donald W. Wright and Johanna Bachmann, USDC for the Central District of California, Civil Action No. 91-6654, JMI, CTx] (LR-13111)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL MULTI-SECTOR FIXED INCOME FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by National Multi-Sector Fixed Income Fund, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit the Funds to issue two classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, one of which would convert into the other class after a specified period permitting investors to benefit from lower Rule 12b-1 distribution fees. The order would also permit the Funds to assess a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares of one of the classes and to waive the CDSC in certain cases. (Rel. IC-18429 - December 3)

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-91-17) under Rule 19b-4 which relates to an OCC service, Risk Management System, to be used by its participant exchanges and clearing members in their assessment and management of risk of positions maintained in proprietary, market professional and customer accounts. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 9. (Rel. 34-30023)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-PCC-91-01) under Rule 19b-4 relating to fees for post clearing services. The proposal became effective upon filing. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 9. (Rel. 34-30024)
