NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted pursuant to provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration. The Commission will not normally meet on Mondays or Fridays.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, DC. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

CLOSED MEETING - TUESDAY, JULY 10, 1984 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the July 10 closed meeting will be: Formal orders of investigation; Institution and settlement of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Litigation matter; Institution and settlement of injunctive actions; Opinions.

OPEN MEETING - THURSDAY, JULY 12, 1984 - 2:30 p.m.

The subject matter of the July 12 open meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of whether to adopt amendments to Securities Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11 (17 CFR 240.15c2-11) which regulates quotations for the over-the-counter securities. The amendments would: (1) extend the rule's information maintenance requirement to the publication of quotations without a specified price and quotations for certain foreign securities and ADRs; (2) create exceptions for NASDAQ securities and for quotations representing a customer's indication of interest; and (3) clarify treatment under the rule of quotations for the securities of reporting companies. (2) Consideration of whether to adopt amendments to Rule 12d-1 under the Investment Company Act which would be renumbered 12d3-1, rescind Rule 2a-3, and adopt related amendments to investment company registration forms. Rule 12d3-1 would permit a registered investment company to acquire securities issued by persons who, directly or indirectly, are brokers, dealers, underwriters, or investment advisers. (3) Consideration of a letter from the Division of Market Regulation to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission commenting on the application of the Chicago Board of Trade for designation as a contract market to trade a proposed futures contract on the Bond Buyer Municipal Bond Index. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

GORDON T. HANSON ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on June 19 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a final judgment of permanent injunction against Gordon T. Hanson restraining and enjoining him from violations of the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. Hanson consented to the judgment without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. The April 26 complaint alleged that Hanson assembled a block of 150,000 unregistered shares of common stock of Grandma Lee's, Inc., a Canadian issuer of which he is an officer, for sale to A.G. Becker Paribas, Inc. in the United States. (SEC v. Gordon T. Hanson, et al., SDNY, Docket No. 84 Civ. 2922 [MJL]). (LR-10441)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST PUBLISHER OF SUCCESSFUL OPTIONS INVESTING

The New York Regional Office announced that on June 20 a complaint was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Options Strategy Associates, Ltd. of Garden City, New York, the publisher of Successful Options Investing, a bi-weekly options letter, OSH Management Associates, Ltd., the general partner of Options Strategy, and Martin Juman of Merrick, New York, the president of OSH Management. The complaint alleges violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Advisers Act and the Commission's advertising rules. Specifically, the complaint charges that the defendants: (1) for compensation, publish and distribute Successful Options Investing without being registered with the Commission as investment advisers; and (2) disseminate false and misleading advertisements to subscribers and prospective subscribers to Successful Options Investing. The complaint requested preliminary and permanent injunctions. (SEC v. Options Strategy Associates, Ltd., et al., 84 Civil 4316, SDNY 1984 [TPG]). (LR-10443)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ACACIA NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Acacia National Life Insurance Company, Acacia National Variable Annuity Account A, and Acacia Equity Sales Corporation from provisions of Sections 22(e), 26(a), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act to permit the transactions described in the application. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
