CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES JOSEPH FOX, OTHERS

The Commission filed a complaint on October 1 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Lubbock Division, against Joseph Fox, David Ball, Patricia Randall, and Carl Fleece. The complaint alleges that each defendant violated the antifraud provision of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 through purchases, on June 9 and 10, 1983, of Texas Instruments, Inc. (TI) puts while in possession of material nonpublic information concerning TI's home computer business of which the defendants had learned from their duties in management positions at TI and learned from each other. The complaint alleges that, at the times of his or her trading, the defendants knew that: TI home computer product line sales were below expectations; TI was considering significant reductions of home computer production; unusual activities, including meetings, were occurring; and a presentation would be made by the subdivision responsible for home computers to the TI Board of Directors on June 10. The complaint asks for injunctions and orders requiring each defendant to disgorge the profits from the fraudulent securities transactions which amounted, in total, to at least \$750,000. (SEC v. CLOYCE K. BOX PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on September 20 Judge Robert M. Hill, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, entered an order permanently enjoining Dallas oilman Cloyce K. Box, former Chairman of the Board of OKC Corp., from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ending litigation between the Commission and Box which had begun in 1978. Box consented to the order without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations.

Under the terms of a settlement reached between the Commission and Box, Box agreed to, and the Commission acknowledged, payment of \$1 million by Box to the OKC Corp. Liquidating Trust for attorneys' fees advanced or paid by or on behalf of OKC in this and related litigation. Additionally, the settlement recited that Box had also obligated himself on certain guarantees on behalf of OKC Corp. Liquidating Trust. (SEC v. Cloyce K. Box, OKC Corp., Civil Action No. 3-80-1217-D). (LR-10547)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CASH ACCUMULATION TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on an application of Cash Accumulation Trust exempting it from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act to permit acquisition of puts from brokers or dealers. (Rel. IC-14177 - Oct. 1)

SOUTHWEST FUNDING CORP.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on an application by Southwest Funding Corporation amending and restating its previous application and requesting a new Commission order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in order to allow it to engage in certain transactions that were not contemplated in the original application, and thus were not covered by the original order. AMERICAN FEDERATION OF LABOR AND CONGRESS
OF INDUSTRIAL ORGANIZATIONS HOUSING INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued exempting the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations Housing Investment Trust and the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations Mortgage Investment Trust from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to implement the proposed merger of the two. (Rel. IC-14179 - Oct. 1)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to create a subsidiary, the initial operations of which will be confined to the preliminary study, investigation, research and development of new business or investment opportunities and the direction, coordination and conduct of such activities. Southern also proposes to acquire common stock in Integrated Communication System, Inc. (Rel. 35-23440 - Oct. 1)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-84-26) to amend the exchange's rules and schedule of fees relating to the arbitration of disputes between public customers and an associated person or a member of the exchange. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 24. (Rel. 34-21360)

FILING AND ORDER GRANTING ACCELERATED PARTIAL APPROVAL

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-84-22) to: (a) allow the introduction of new series of index options until the beginning of the month in which the series would expire; (b) establish strike price intervals of \$5.00 or more for index options regardless of the value of the underlying index; and (c) allow the listing of as many as seven strike prices upon the introduction of a new expiration month for an index option. The Commission also approved, on an accelerated basis, the first two portions of this proposed rule change. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 1. (Rel. 34-21362)

DEADLINE EXTENSION

The Commission issued a release under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 extending the deadline for agency action on two proposed rule changes of the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-84-15 and CBOE-84-16) until December 22, 1984. (Rel. 34-21361)
